Steer Backgrounding Venture

The Granite Ridge breeding philosophy has always been about weight for age and carcass.

In 2016 we decided to set up a buy-back program of Granite Ridge sired steers to prove what our cattle can do.

This program has been more successful than we could ever have hoped. All feed-back has been very positive, proving that the Granite Ridge breeding program is on track genetically and profitably for our Clients.

Anyone can take their best steers and enter them into carcass competitions and win top prizes. Granite Ridge has sent hundreds of GR sired steers to a feedlot and then on to kill. This year when 2 Double loads were killed, every carcass was passed with an average return of 64 percent carcass weight - the Feedlot was contacted asking them to send more like these.

This gives you the true picture of accurate results.
