May/June 2018 drop mulesed, jetted with Coopers BlowFly and Lice off shears, all needles and animal health treatments are up to date. Wool cut 5.0 kgs greasy at 10 mths growth. Aug '19 shorn, NSM.

1,500 Wyvern Bred Merino Ewes

May/June 2014 drop mulesed, jetted with Coopers BlowFly and Lice off shears, all needles and animal health treatments are up to date. Marked 107% lambs. Wool cut 7.1 kgs at 12 mths growth (Sep '18 figures). Sep '19 shorn, NSM.

2,450 Wyvern Bred Merino Ewes

May/June 2013 drop mulesed, jetted with Coopers BlowFly and Lice off shears, all needles and animal health treatments are up to date. Marked 107% lambs. Wool cut 7.1 kgs at 12 mths growth (Sep '18 figures). Sep '19 shorn, NSM.

4,800 Wyvern Bred Wether Lambs

May/June 2019 drop mulesed (pain relief used), jetted with Extinosad at weaning, all needles and animal health treatments are up to date. Unshorn.

Wyvern is a well renowned property for breeding quality wool growing sheep. Over many years of good management, the flock has produced heavy wool cutting, highly fertile ewes with a great mothering ability to wean high percentages of lambs each year.

TA Field Estates P/L has a contract ram breeding program with Hazeldean Merino Stud at Cooma, where rams are bred, reared and weaned then sent out to Rosevale, Hay to grow out. Once the rams are 1 ½ years of age, they are then selected for Wyvern's breeding program through the use of the MP + Index.

The main production traits selected for seek to increase both fleece and body weight, whilst reducing micron.

Wyvern regularly participates in the highly regarded Peter Westblade Merino Challenge Wether Trial. Most recently, Wyvern 2016 drop wethers were entered, shorn in 2017 and again in 2018 and averaged 17.2 micron, 91 ml and 42 nkt. Overall, Wyvern finished in the top 20% of trial participants.

The sale will run in conjunction with Auctions Plus and full assessments of the sheep will be available from the Auctions Plus website from the 26TH of September. All sheep will be presented in wonderful condition and are the annual drafts of surplus sheep from Wyvern Station. Trucks will be available on the sale day.

All sheep assessments will be available from the 26TH September, 2019 through the Auctions Plus website: <http://auctionsplus.com.au> All lines to be sold in 4 and 6 deck lots and all sheep are required to be taken for delivery on the day.

NB: The sale will be conducted in the Riverina Sheep Biosecurity Group and the sheep are eligible to go to other Biosecurity areas such as South Australia and Queensland. Lunch available and supplied by the Carrathool Sports Club.
