Veterinary Report.

On Friday the 23rd of October 2020, I inspected 8 wagyu animals that were being sold via Auction Plus. The cattle were owned by Michael Betar and were inspected on Back Brawlin Road, Cootamundra, NSW.

The following was found on inspection:

- **MJA16:** Wagyu Bull, D.O.B 19/4/19. Clinical Exam – No Abnormalities Detected. Old scar on right flank. Testicles and penis appeared normal. Eyes clear.
- **MJA7:** Wagyu Bull, D.O.B November, 2016. Clinical Exam- No Abnormalities Detected. Testicles and penis appeared normal. Eyes clear.
- **MJA9:** Wagyu Bull. D.O.B November 2016. Clinical Exam- Bull appears to have acute angles bilaterally in his stifle and hocks. He appeared to be lame in his right hind leg when walking and moved with a shuffling gait. He was unsound. Testicles and penis appeared normal. Eyes are clear.
- **MJA20-** Wagyu Bull. D.O.B 13/8/19. Clinical Exam- No Abnormalities Detected. Testicles and penis appeared normal. Eyes clear.
- **BarH 1613:** Wagyu Cow, D.O.B 2014. She had calved in July 2020 and still has the calf at foot. She was Not Detectably Pregnant (NDP) at the time of examination. Both her internal and external genital tract palpated normally. Clinical examination- No Abnormalities Detected. Eyes were clear.
- **BarH 1457:** Wagyu Cow, D.O.B 2014. Clinical Exam- No Abnormalities Detected. She was more than 4 months pregnant (ACV red Tag) at the time of examination. Both her internal and external genital tract palpated normally. Eyes were clear.
- **BarH 1572:** Wagyu Cow, D.O.B 2014. Clinical exam- She had multiple, round, hard lumps of differing sizes (3cm-10cm) in her rectum. I was unable to pregnancy test her due to the lumps identified. She calved in April 2020 and still has the calf at foot. Eyes were clear.
- **MJA18:** Wagyu Heifer. D.O.B 19/4/19. Clinical Exam- No Abnormalities Detected. She was less than 3 months in calf (ACV green Tag) at the time of examination. Both her internal and external genital tract palpate normally. Eyes were clear.
