With the continuing move to self replacing prime lamb systems Cashmore Oaklea and our clients are pleased to offer 10,000 of these purpose bred ewes to the market via the Auctions Plus selling platform this year.

At the stud level selection pressure applied to the profitable performance drivers for prime lambs, primarily fertility and growth, coupled with the easy care traits of mothering ability and worm resistance, sees these animals' genetic performance increase \$7.55 per ewe mated per year.

At the commercial level the use of top 10% rams, condition scoring of ewes, pregnancy scanning and wet and dry at marking further produces high performing flocks under good management conditions.

Douglas Cameron, Mona Vale Holdings, Ross, Tasmania

Mona Vale Holdings is a mixed farming operation located at Ross in Tasmania. We farm in a diverse range of soils with an average annual rainfall of 400 mm. We have been using high indexing Cashmore Oaklea rams for 20 years in our self-replacing flock producing approximately 25,000 lambs a year.

Our focus is on robust mature ewes with excellent fertility, high scanning to weaning percentages and high growth rates.

With Cashmore Oaklea genetics we have achieved excellent ewe lamb performance with lambs that are joined at 7 months of age and scanned 165% for the 2020 lambing.



Don Pegler and Lyon family, Oaklea, Mt Gambier, SA

Don Pegler and Lyon family farm south of Mt Gambier right on the coast with free draining limestone and flint based soils, but are prone to very wet and windy conditions during lambing. Their commercial maternal wether lambs are sold as suckers at heavy trade weights through the Mt Gambier saleyards with the sister portion offered each year in the Cashmore Oaklea ewe sale.

These are June/July drop giving clients a little more weight and age and allowing an earlier mating from these well grown ewe lambs.

These lambs are all bred from sound CFA ex stud ewes that have been pushed from the flock by higher performing daughters.

An entire drop of ex Stud ewes is also offered.



John and Brigita Keiller, Cashmore Park, Cashmore, VIC

Cashmore Park is a 1400 ha grazing property located 10km West of Portland, VIC, in a 830 mm rainfall zone. It runs 25,000 DSE with a 90; 10 sheep cattle mix.

This action has produced fertile, free lambing easily managed sheep with adult ewes regularly pregnancy scanning 180%.

The commercial flock consists of self replacing Performance Maternal ewes producing heavy trade carcasses, feeder lambs and breeding ewes. All ewes are pregnancy scanned with drys and wet/drys at marking sold.

We offer August/September drop ewe lambs, some middle aged commercial ewes at client's request and a run of mostly ex Stud, sound mouth CFA ewes each year.



Jim, Andrea and Tom Pegler, Pegler Pastoral, Thornlea, SA

Pegler Pastoral Co have been breeding self replacing Cashmore Oaklea sheep since 2006. We farm at Thornlea and Kalangadoo in the south east of South Australia.

Only twin ewe lambs are retained as future breeders and all rams purchased are in the top 1% EBVs.

We lamb down in June/July with a 145% marking rate after a hard start to the season.

Our long term goals are to further increase our lambing percentages with earlier lambing and improve survival rates through genetic selection and improved management practices.



Phillip O'Toole, O'Toole Family Trust, Hawkesdale, VIC

Trading as O'Toole Family Trust (formerly 'Bermuda Partnership')

Ewe replacements are only selected from twin conceptions, and then on their ability to become pregnant and then lamb at 1 year old.

The O'Toole's farm at Hawkesdale, which is 38kms North of Port Fairy. Sheep are by far the main farming enterprise with the stocking pressure 95% of total stock run.

Elite Composite rams are bought from the Cashmore Oaklea top 5% sale. To maximise their genetic influence on the flock, they are used at 0.5% over ewes that will give the highest % of lambs for the 1st cycle of joining, follow up rams are then added to complete joining.

We are dedicated to running Composite sheep. No terminal rams are used, which gives us a large number of ewe lambs to select replacements from. Strong selection pressure can then be placed on traits, such as fertility, resilience, including worm resistance, and feet, etc.

All the ewe lambs offered for sale are the result of a twin gestation, 80% of them reared as a twin (160% marking).



Russel and Fiona Mitchell, Rusex Partnership, Glenthompson, VIC

Our farm is at Glenthompson in a 600 mm rainfall. We have been using only Cashmore Oaklea rams for the past 12 years, purchasing from the "elite" section of the catalog.

care, producing high performance lambs that can be processed at 5 months of age.

Due to the success of our self replacing maternal composites, we have decided to expand our operation and start supplying the replacement breeder market.

We lamb in early July and all lambs are sold by the middle of December.

Our ram selection focus is on low birth weight, high early growth and keeping our adult weights down. This selection means our ewes are easy

Last year 98% of the wether lambs were sold off the property by the 3rd December at an average dressed weight of 22.5kg after growing at an average of 356g per day for the entire drop.

We have found the Cashmore Oaklea genetics to be easy care, productive and profitable.



Rob Costin, Lochs Farming, Hordern Vale, VIC

Farming 1400ha at Hordern Vale and Apollo Bay, Lochs Farming is currently running 6000+ maternal composite ewes along with beef breeding and trading.

Run in 1100mm rainfall, the ewes consistently perform under high stocking rates and tough lambing conditions.

The genetic selections have focussed on high growth, EMD and Fat while maintaining an average mature body weight of 64kg in CS3.

The last two years have seen an average marking rate of 151% to ewes joined, with the majority of lambs sold at trade weights.



Dale and Jase Bateman, Kanangra, Furner, SA

Dale and Jase are a mixed cattle and sheep enterprise. After originally buying first cross ewes annually, we decided eight years ago to start buying in Cashmore Oaklea so we could self replace.

The flock is currently 1200 ewes with plans to grow the numbers.

We lamb down in late May through to June. Currently the lambing percentage is approximately 150 and has seen a P increase over the past years.

All self replacing ewes are only kept out of scanned twin ewes.



Andrew Whale, Whale Partnership, Hamilton, VIC

Whale partnership purchased ewe lambs from John Keiller in December 2019 as a run of twin born ewe lambs, and has run these ewe lambs as dry ewes for the year, specifically to on sell as 1.5 YO ewes ready to join.

They have been run 5km South of Hamilton for the year and are freshly shorn.

The works is done with these ewes and they are ready to perform. You can purchase knowing that the genetics are elite as they are the direct bloodlines of Cashmore Park.



Jeff and Jane Glare, Killara, Tarrone, VIC

Our farm is 20km north of Port Fairy. We run a 4000 head of self-replacing composite flock, in a wet environment with high stocking rates.

We join enough ewes to composite rams for replacements, with the balance to terminals.

We've been using Cashmore Oaklea rams for the past seven years and select mainly for hardiness and fertility, aiming for 140%+



R & L Manifold, Meekri, Weerite, VIC

The "Meekri" flock had a long history of Coopworth use but recently has been using Cashmore Oaklea blood rams to increase performance.

Fast growth rates to weaning, higher lambing percentages and a tolerance to parasites on a robust ewe that can handle winters on heavy soils are aimed at.

A pasture renovation program and flock expansion has seen total livestock numbers lift under management of Tim Nolan and inputs from Growth Farms Australia.

The 500 July drop ewe lambs offered would be well suited to a March joining in 2021.



Tom Casey, Willatook, VIC

Tom Casey runs a self replacing Maternal flock at Willatook NE of Port Fairy on heavy black flats and stony barrier country. It can be very wet in the winter and his stock are noted for how they come through hard times and are always presented well by a very good sheep man.

Abattoir production targets are heavy trade weight specifications from Maternal wethers and Poll Dorset sired lambs from older ewes.

He has found the Cashmore Oaklea ewe lambs to be very fertile and offers pregnancy tested ewe lambs each July at 50 kg live weight.

Tom has supported this sale for a long time and sets up a good run of ewe lambs and 1.5 year olds each year which have been well received by purchasers. This year he is also offering some adult ewes.

Stock sold this year due to relinquish of lease.



Ken and Carmen, Varcoe, Terenga, Kalangadoo, SA

Terenga is located 40km south of Mt Gambier, 30 km East of Millicent near Kalangadoo in 800 mm rainfall zone.

Terenga runs 2300 Cashmore Oaklea blood composite ewes. Initially purchasing ewes from Cashmore Park in 2006, subsequently purchasing Cashmore Oaklea rams in the top 10% (recently 5%) of the Maternal Index.

The focus at Terenga has been to produce hardy highly fertile ewes (140-150%) with good early growth and worm resistance that perform under high stocking rates.

Terenga's program has been centred on producing large numbers of quality breeders for those seeking replacements.
