PROTOCOL AT INSPECTIONS

There will be one and only one entrance to the facilities and all individuals will be asked to sign in and sign out, providing your address and time of arrival and departure. We will keep

this information in a secure and private place.

If you have recently returned from overseas or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 or have been generally unwell recently please ask some one else to do the inspection for you. We would prefer you not to inspect the animals.

We will not provide you with refreshments during inspec-

tions as we do not have the facilities to do so safely. We do not have the facilities for hand washing so we would ask you to provide your own hand sanitiser. We do not have access to masks, toilet paper or gloves to protect you. If you need these products you will have to provide them for yourself.

You should also observe social distancing recommendations. It is recommended that you keep a metre and a half away from any and all other people at all times.

There is conflicting evidence about the ability of the virus to survive outside people on other surfaces. Please note that gates and gate handles are potential sources of infection. You might consider seriously whether you should wear a plastic glove when opening or closing gates. And wash or sanitize your hands after handling gates.

Bear in mind that the effects of a COVID-19 are believed to be more serious for older people—please adjust your behaviour accordingly.
