Terms & Conditions of Sale

- Auction will be run as a sequential sale in conjunction with a physical sale. The auction will be conducted at regular saleyard speed and buyers are encouraged to use Limit Bids or Auto Bids to ensure full participation. The auctioneer's decision is final
- Buyers intending to purchase online are encouraged to pre-register
- Trading Terms are that of the individual Selling Agency, and in bidding online all buyers agree to abide by these terms. AuctionsPlus recommend contacting individual agents prior to sale to establish trading terms
- Sequential pens of cattle account same vendor will be available to purchase as runs at the bid price. These lots will be identified in the final catalogue. Online buyers wishing to purchase runs must nominate PRIOR to commencement of auction by completing the Buyer Allocation Form
- All cattle will be weighed prior to sale, after a minimum 8-hour curfew. The (approximate) time of arrival at yards will be displayed in the catalogue
- Cattle will be weighed in pen lots, and the average weight and total pen weight displayed in the catalogue
- Risk passes to the purchaser at the fall of the hammer
- Buyers purchasing via AuctionsPlus will retain all misdescription protections for traits defined in the catalogue (excluding Live Weight) as per the AuctionsPlus User Agreement and Sale Terms
- In the event of a Dispute being raised in accordance with the AuctionsPlus User Agreement and Sale Terms, the cattle remain the responsibility of the purchaser until such time the dispute is resolved
- NLIS transfers will be completed by Outcross. Online purchasers must advise Outcross of transport arrangements within one hour of the completion of the sale
- SELX requires all purchased livestock to be vacated from the premises within 24 hours post sale. Where stock are not removed from the site within 24 hours the owner or representative must advise the SELX Saleyard Manager, Rick Maslin – 0499 611 222 of the transport arrangements. Please note that any stock remaining on the premises at 9am Saturday 25th April will be mandatorily fed and the buyer charged \$4.40 per head per feed
