Another PB 43 son and very much in keeping in he same style-well covered, good fiber density while maintaining staple length while keeping the brilliance of 'elite' wool crimp, colour and character. Carries double copy polls (PP).

The dam of 036 is GP 013379 (also a double copy PP ewe herself). This ewe comes from 5 generations of ET breeding. Her sire is Wallaloo Park 988 and her dam is GP 090011 (this ewe is a full flush sister to the two ET bred rams in Adelaide in 2010 for \$14,000 and \$17,000 respectively. She also is the dam of the sire GP 011380 which was sold for a half share of \$20,000. The dam pedigree on this ram is impressive!!
