Surgery Report Animal: Dandilla Ex Girl Client: Dandilla Pastoral Company

The Australian Stock Horse filly presented as *Dandilla Ex Girl*, underwent removal of a small sequestrum off the medial aspect of the left fore cannon bone on the 1st of July 2020 at the Darling Downs Vets Equine facility, Westbrook. The filly had a history of previous trauma to the mid cannon.

Surgical Procedure

Left Fore Cannon bone: The filly was anaesthetized in routine fashion. The medial aspect of the left fore cannon was clipped and aseptically prepared. An elliptical incision was made around an osseous swelling in the mid cannon and excess skin removed. Reactive periosteal was sharp transected and removed to expose new bone formation with a central sequestrum. The reactive bone and sequestrum was removed with chisel to healthy margins. Some overlying scar tissue was removed and the skin margins sutured in typical fashion.

Recovery was unremarkable.

Prognosis

Based on surgical findings it is expected the filly will have a good prognosis for future performance. Some swelling may remain in the overlying soft tissues with a resultant cosmetic blemish.
