Welcome to our annual Anderson Rams sale.

To meet increasing demand, the size of our sale ram team has increased again this year and we are pleased to report that even with more rams, the **average** DP+ index of the auction rams has also lifted, and at 187 is in the **top 5%** of values in Merinoselect.

In fact, the averages of ALL traits listed in our catalogue has increased over last years' averages and remain well above industry averages for all production traits and easy care traits. In this catalogue you will find rams that have numerous traits in the top 1% of Merinoselect, as you have come to expect from Anderson Rams.

Particularly pleasing is the number of exceptionally worm resistant rams on offer this year. This is the culmination of 18 years of careful selection on this medium-lowly heritable trait to breed a worm resistant flock without compromising production or structure.

THESE RAMS HAVE BEEN DIPPED

Recently we discovered lice on the property for the first time in 15 years. While it is unlikely that the ram flock had been exposed, we could not take the risk, however small, of passing it onto any buyers, hence the rams have all been dipped.

It has caused us considerable anguish and we apologise that we have been unable to present the sale rams in their normal condition, with their white wools on display.


Fortunately for us our buyers are savvy with recognising that it is a ram's genetic potential that determines how it will breed, not just how it looks, and know that the high accuracy of the rams' breeding values give confidence in the ASBVs and what their progeny will be like.

We sell semen and rams widely across Australia to a large number of studs as well as commercial growers. For studs, infusing our genetics can mean leap-frogging ahead in their own breeding values and accuracies particularly for traits like worm resistance where progress by natural selection in a single flock can take many years.


Anderson Rams is the most worm resistant flock in Australia and very likely the world.

Genetic Graphs-how we are progressing


The orange line is Anderson, blue line is MERINOSELECT average, red line is Fine/Medium Average




Post Weaning Weight



Yearling Eye Muscle




Yearling Clean Fleece Weight




Yearling Worm Egg Count





- Conception (Con)
- Litter Size (LS)
- Ewe Rearing Ability (ERA) and
- Maternal Behaviour Score (MBS)
 as Merinoselect transitions from
 Number of Lambs Weaned (NLW) to
 these new traits that facilitate

enhanced lamb survival.
