The Palgrove stud is based in Warwick Qld, with our female herds also located at Ben Lomond and Inverell, NSW. Our bull depot is located at Miles, QLD. For over fifty years, we've adapted our Charolais genetics by committing to research, education, new technologies and a common sense 'cattleman's eye' to suit clients' environmental and management conditions. Palgrove now has the largest registered Charolais herd in Australia.

In 2009, we started developing our Ultrablack bull breeding program. We're positive that they offer another profitable option to our clients' production and target markets. We're excited to offer Ultrablacks bulls for the first time this year at our Hunter Valley sale.

Our bulls are grown out on pasture with moderate sale preparation. We believe a bull's career begins on sale day, so our sale bulls are presented to you ready to work.

Auctionsplus

Auctionsplus is an alternate bidding option. Only available to registered users. Please register online at least 24hrs prior to the sale.

Breeding Soundness

All bulls offered for sale have passed a semen test by Veterinarian, Ced Wise. The Vet will examine all bulls for structural and breeding soundness to Australian Veterinary Standards and will issue a Soundness Evaluation Certificate.

The Markets

In our comments on most sale lots we've made some suggestions as to the most suitable market options for the progeny by the bulls. Some will fit a broad range.

Several factors influence the outcome of breeding - such as the breed makeup of your cows; seasonal conditions during the growth stage; country and management.

In making these market suggestions, we consider a number of factors:

Supplementary Sheet

The bulls have scan data supplied by certified scanning technician, David Reid for Eye Muscle Area, Rump & Rib Fat, Marbling (IMF%) and will also have sale Weight and Scrotal Size measurements.

Guarantee

All bulls sold by Palgrove are guaranteed breeders. Any claim against the breeding ability of an animal purchased should be made in writing and accompanied by a Veterinary certificate within six months of the date of sale. If a bull fails to breed, it may either be replaced with an animal of comparable value or credit to the full purchase price will be given at any of Palgrove's auction sales or by private treaty.

Health

Palgrove is an accredited TB and Brucellosis free herd and all Palgrove properties are recognised as Johnes Disease Protected (J-BAS 7), so stock are free to move anywhere in Australia (please note WA eligibility).

All sale bulls have vaccinated twice with 7-in-1, 3 Day Sickness and Pestigard vaccine & blooded for Tick Fever.

Delivery

We take personal interest in the efficient delivery of all bulls after sale. The agents oversee all deliveries of sale bulls. We will assist in the delivery of bulls where possible in the Hunter Valley or on route to the Qld border via Tamworth.

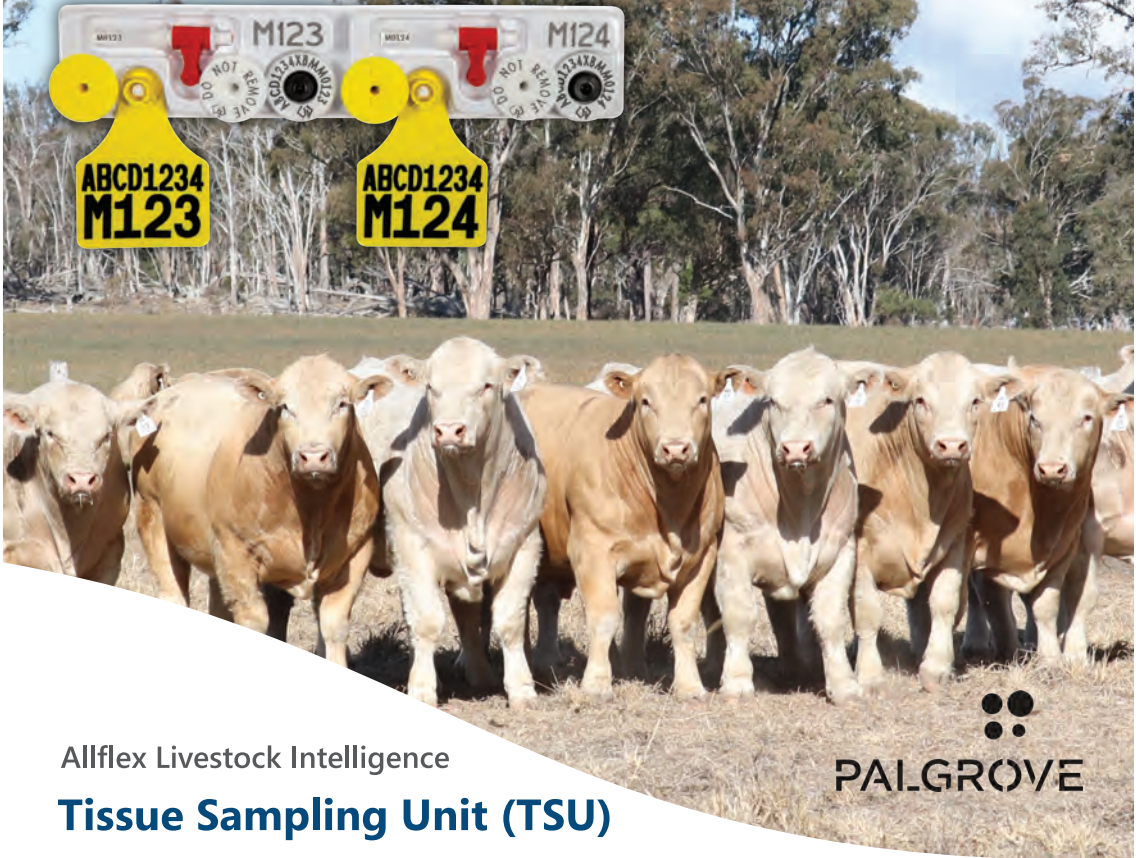

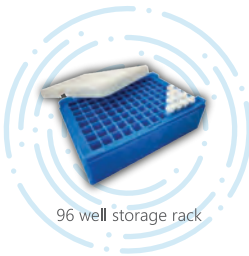

Improved carcase quality, market acceptance and superior fertility is further proof as to why Palgrove Ultrablack genetics are now demanding even more attention in terms of profitability for commercial producers which we define as key profit drivers.

Palgrove Ultrablack's have proven their adaptability in some of the country's harshest environments while providing diversity for producers to hit the 'top end' of their target market - organic, grass finished and grain fed.

Interest from premium end users in China and Palgrove's belief in their genetics to perform from the paddock to plate, was the motivation for a trial shipment of boxed Ultrablack beef into China.

The ultimate aim was hoping for a marble score 2+ on a 150 day grain fed product, milk to two tooth, HGP Free with an entry weight of 380-480kg.

The trial was conducted on 61, yearling Ultrablack heifers with an average entry weight of 354kg. No losses were recorded throughout the trial and health treatments were well below average. Over the 150 days on feed the group averaged a gain of 1.6kg/day.

Ben Noller, Palgrove went onto say there were initial fears entering such young stock into the trial, "Our expectations of consistently meeting the marble score specifications were low, considering the age of the animals, however the results were astonishing, a real testament to the Palgrove breeding programme. All 61 heifers graded between 2 and 6 for marbling, with half of the draft (34 head) ranking 3 or better, with 16 head ranking over 4. To reach a maximum marble grade of 6 on two bodies, greatly exceeded all expectations of Palgrove and the Chinese customer".

He added, "Palgrove has never focused on single trait selection and we've always implemented a balanced approach on selection criteria and breeding philosophies. The demand for improved fertility and efficient weight gain in combination with carcase quality still sits as Palgrove's number one priority in future breeding decisions". "Whether you buy one or 100 bulls, our aim is always on improving the profitability of our customers. This trial has proven our breeding direction is achieving premium market demands".

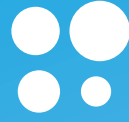
