Auctions Plus sale of Suffolk & White Suffolk semen reserves

Terms & Conditions

- **1.** This auction will run over two days, commencing on Wednesday 21st July 2021 at 9am EST, closing on the afternoon of Thursday 22nd July from 3pm EST, when timed bidding towards will commence with an initial 60 second timer, then reduced to a 30 second timer. The clock will restart after each new bid. When no bids are received within the allocated timing period, the auction will end.
- 2. The auction will be simultaneous, with all lots open for bidding at the same time.
- **3.** Each lot will be clearly identified when bidding has reached the vendor reserve; and it will then be 'on the market'.
- **4.** Bidding will be on a per dose basis, with the successful bidder having their successful bid price multiplied by the number of doses to determine the end price for each lot.
- **5.** Bids are to be in a minimum of \$5/dose, but higher multiples are allowable.
- **6.** Lots marked with a bracketed number, eg (x2,) indicate that the winning bidder will have the option of increasing the volume they take in that sire/s. For example, a lot with 60 doses and marked (x2), will mean that when contacted by the sale agents, the winning bidder can increase their purchased lot's volume from the original 60 doses up to 120 doses, or any negotiated figure in between. If the winning bidder chooses not to increase the volume of their purchase (if available), the underbidder(s) will be offered the option at the winning bid price less \$5/dose.
- **7.** Semen is only being offered in rams identified as Spider Syndrome free through testing or pedigree. One of the two original imported rams from the USA (Holwegner Quantas 51) was unfortunately identified as a carrier, along with 4 of his descendants that we had collected semen from; none having semen in this sale offering, but there are descendants that are SS clean. As a further surety measure, three rams catalogued with a known carrier in their background are pending further verification of their Spider Syndrome free status should they come back as carriers, they will be withdrawn from the sale prior to the auction.
- **8.** Any surplus semen after the completion of this sale and the resultant volume negotiations and transactions, may be listed and offered via tender offers. No tender will necessarily be accepted.
- **9.** All semen was collected and frozen to the highest standards available at the time of collection. Despite the time since some was collected, results from our Laparoscopic AI program for the presale mating this year indicate all semen to be of good viable quality, producing overall pregnancy rates of 60% to 70%.
- **10.** From the limited inventory checks we have been able to undertake in the circumstances of Stan's illness and subsequent passing, we believe the semen allocated to the listed lots is in storage and available for your competition. Should we subsequently find that not to be the case for any listed ram, we will negotiate with the purchaser, either a cancellation of the sale, or semen from a suitable replacement sire.
- **11.** The semen being offered is currently stored at either Dale River Transplants (Westdale, WA), &/or Brecon Breeders (Keith, SA). While we will facilitate transit of the semen to purchasers, charges from either, or both of these facilities are the responsibility of the purchasers.

APS Semen Lots

SUFFOLKS

The Imports (USA)

Lot 1 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x3)

Brigham Young University 'Supreme' 21T3 Twin (USA)

Comments: BYU 'Supreme' 21T3 Tw (Imp USA) Our first import ram, and one of the most successful from one of the very top studs in the USA at the time, Brigham Young University 'Supreme' 21T3 Twin. The first photo is of him (at the front) in quarantine at Torrens Island. The second photo is of his twin brother winning a championship in the USA soon after. The third is his pedigree. The sire is Treasure Valley 'Colt' - probably the best headed Suffolk ram we have ever seen. This is the ram that set us on our way - the successful foundation to our 37 year program with imported USA & UK genetics.

Lot 2 – 60 doses (20 pellets)

Mohawk Valley 'John' WH34 (USA)

Comments: The 2 images are his pedigree, and a photo of his top son that we used in the flock, A041483 ET. After the initial importation, we set up a flock in the USA where we could firstly source rams of approved blood type, then undergo all the testing and quarantine protocols required in the USA, thus we then did not need to repeat the 8 years quarantine we had to undergo first time round. MV 'John' was the first of 4 new USA rams we brought in via semen from 2003 to 2006. He gave us a very different bloodline to work with from our original imports. He came from the eastern side of the US, from New York state. Interestingly, at the time of our original import sourcing, Gerald was already in the US looking for Angus bulls for his family's Landfall Angus stud in Tasmania. He had contact with Roger Nichols, with the RDN Suffolk flock being one of the most highly regarded in the USA at that time. Gerald sourced some stock from there, but RDN stud principals pulled out when they found out the extent of testing the sheep had to undergo. Thus, it was a pleasing result when we were able to import 'John' semen, as he carried RDN bloodlines. There is very limited reserves in 'John', so this sale offers a great, but rare opportunity for breeders in this country.

Lot 3 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x5)

Batt 'The Brick' 8Y9 Twin (USA)

Comments: The 4 photos below though are of some of his first progeny - the first one show a pure Suffolk son that we nicknamed 'Tree Trunks' because of the strength of bone he carried - he is only a few weeks old in this photo. The other 3 photos are of progeny out of White Suffolk ewes - the first 2 are of three full ET brothers, including 040535 that we used in the stud quite a bit. The last one is of a cracking ram that unfortunately we lost before we got to use him. All these White Suffolk cross sons were 10 months of age. Brick carries BYU blood, but has outcrosses from Luxford, Andrus & Larson blood, but most importantly he comes from an exceptionally commercially focused background. There was no 'show scene' in his selection background at all, but rather, he was bred with an emphasis on feed conversion efficiency.

Lot 4 – 60 doses (60 straws) (x2)

Wilt 'The Ticket' 9660 (USA)

Comments: "The Ticket" has proven to be an exceptional breeding sire within our program. He has all the USA commercial attributes, especially growth rate and length of body, while consistently breeding stock with outstanding breed type and style. His genetic background is dominated by Brigham Young University bloodlines, which we regarded as the leading flock in the USA at the time. He had a very strong influence on both our Suffolk and White Suffolk flocks, with his top White Suffolk son (A040869 ET) being one of our most prominent sires in that program. The photos are of some of his first ewe lambs in 2004, plus 2 of the top White Suffolk infused sons, A041138 & A040869.

Lot 5 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x3)

Cloud 246 Twin (USA)

Comments: Cloud 246 is a ram we had specifically bred in our USA based program to suit our longer-term breeding needs, being the last of our six USA imported sires. All were successful, but Cloud not only offered us a different bloodline mix, but also went on to produce the most outstanding US bloodline progeny within our program. George Bros, Double H and Whisper flocks all had a very strong focus on genotype performance traits and this showed in Cloud's progeny. His top son, A110637 ET also had a huge impact in the APS program, with 637's sons 140202 and 140250 also excelling. Every APS ram used from 2014 drop onwards carried some Cloud bloodlines.

Note: No semen is being offered in Holwegner Quantas 51 as he is Spider Syndrome carrier.

The Imports (UK)

Lot 6 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x2)

Westend 'Panache' E39:P27

Comments: Panache is one of our two UK imports from 2004, the first new UK genetics to come into Australia for over 50 years. This is a unique offering and one not likely to be repeated anytime in the foreseeable future. "Panache" was bred by David Steel and he carries bloodlines from several of the elite Scottish studs. There have been very few of his bloodline descendants released into the Australian marketplace before, but Anthony and Jude Pearce, Telpara had success at Adelaide Royal with his great grandson (descendant pictured photo 3). The other 2 photos are of the pure UK blood lambs soon after they were dropped (photo Farm Weekly), and some of those ewe lambs after weaning "Panache" appears to throw progeny slightly more moderate than our other UK import, Meikleson "Mighty Man". The total APS semen reserves of 120 ewe doses of Panache are on offer in this lot with the double up option.

Note: No semen is being offered in Meikleson 'Mighty Man' DZA:U20 as all his semen reserves have been used.

Pure Progeny (USA & UK Blood)

Lot 7 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x4)

Advancer 2439 ET (100% USA Blood)

Comments: Here is the best of the best progeny from our original imports. Not only is hA2439 (photos 1 & 2) 100% USA, but he is by the great BYU Supreme 21T3 and out of the top Holwegner ewe we imported (pictured photo 3). Spider clean, he has bred exceptionally well wherever he has been used. Semen was sold from him upon quarantine release in 1992 @\$200/dose. He sold to New Zealand for \$24,000 and his three top sons (photo 4) sold to \$30,000 and averaged \$25,000 upon release (two to New Zealand and one to SA).

Lot 8 – 66 doses (22 pellets)

Advancer 040860 ET (100% UK Blood)

Comments: This is the only other opportunity to purchase 100% UK blood genetics. Advancer 040860 (pictured at 5 weeks of age) is sired by Panache and like his sire, he is rich in bloodlines from many of the very top Scottish studs, plus has a dam outcross slightly different from the other UK embryos we imported. If you can't get "Panache", here's your next best option. The total APS supplies of 66 doses are on offer in this lot.

High Percentage UK Blood

Lot 9 – 60 doses (60 straws) (x3)

Advancer 'Scotty' 110460 ET (87.5% UK, 10% USA, 2.5% Aus)

Comments: After we lost the use of our 100% UK rams A040865 and A040872, other than the remaining semen reserves in lot 6 and 8, we did have a strong UK bloodline to call on to produce the blends we were concentrating on. "Scotty" 110460 was our saving grace. He is very much UK in type, with the bonus of carrying "Panache" on the sire side and "Mighty Man" on the dam side. He is 87.5% UK blood with a 10% USA influence through "The Ticket" and a dash of Australian. This is a great package. Again, if you can't get Panache or A040860's semen packages at lots 6 & 8, then this is your next best option to get the UK influence for your breeding flock.

High Percentage USA Blood

Lot 10 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x2)

Advancer 920016 ET (94% USA Blood)

Comments: With Holwegner Quantas 51/83 and his top son (A2440/85 ET) virtually made redundant in our breeding program (Spider carriers), then the next best option was this ram, his grandson A920016 ET. He proved to be Spider Syndrome clean and with 94% USA blood dominated by the Holwegner line, completed with a dash of Renrut, Allendale and Stonehaven blood, he became our best breeding ram to retain all the attributes Holwegner had. The photos show his sire A852440 ET (at 10 weeks of age on recipient Corriedale ewes) and his grandsire, the imported USA sire Holwegner 'Quantas' 51/83. A920016 ET was entered in the last of the National Sire Progeny Tests in the 1990s, and outperformed all other entries.

Lot 11 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x4)

Advancer 930042 ET (81% USA Blood)

Here is an exciting option never released before. He is 81% USA, being sired by A2439 (sons to \$30,000) and carries the bloodlines of both the original USA imports. The sire of the dam is the maternal brother of 12231/89 sold to New Zealand for \$25,000, but as we were unable to collect A12231 before export we kept his maternal brother. We were initially unable to successfully freeze 4037's semen, so 930042 was never released, despite many offers for him as we were unable to guarantee his Spider Status. Both he and 4037 and now tested clean. We displayed A930042 at the 1994 Melbourne Royal where he created a lot of interest & we received several offers to buy him, but without knowing his Spider Status at that time, we were not prepared to sell him.

Lot 12 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x3)

Advancer 2938/87 Twin (AI) (75% USA Blood)

Comments: This ram and his twin brother (lot 13) were standouts from our initial breeding within quarantine and ample proof that you do not need to have extreme USA blood to get the huge growth advantages they offer. He had "fighting damage" to one testicle prior to release, but was still snapped up by Pam Hinkley, Pamellen stud for \$17,500 (under guarantee), where he had a significant impact, despite his injury.

Lot 13 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x3)

Advancer 2939/87 Twin (AI) (75% USA Blood)

Comments: Twin brother to lot 12, A2939 was clearly one of the standout rams at release in 1992. Sired by BYU 'Supreme' 21T3 Tw, he was 75% USA blood. He was the heaviest ram in the flock and was sold to Bob Seaton, New Zealand for \$25,000. His first progeny were extremely prominent in NZ and included the National Champion at Canterbury in 1993. Like his twin brother, he is glowing proof that you can get all the growth, feed conversion, muscling and bone advantages of the USA bloodlines, even with lower blood percentages.

Lot 14 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x3)

Advancer 4037/88 Twin (AI) (75% USA Blood)

Comments: This is the maternal brother of 12231/89 that sold to New Zealand for \$25,000. Both 4037 and 12231 carried extreme muscling through the loin and had great hindquarter conformation, clearly the best in this area from the USA types. He was selected by "Renrut" principal and APS partner Ian Turner as his dividend selection upon release from quarantine. He was only used sparingly in the APS program due to us not knowing his Spider Status until recently, plus we had other known status options. Now confirmed Spider Syndrome clean, he presents a great option for Australian studs to catch up on the advantages enjoyed by New Zealanders since 1992. A December drop lamb, he is pictured at Torrens Island when just 4 months of age, before the sheep were relocated to Kirra Quarantine Station.

Lot 15 – 60 doses (60 straws)

Advancer 060760 (AI) (81% USA Blood)

Comments: A060760 is one of the few sons of "The Brick" that we collected from. That is primarily because we had plenty of his sire's semen to be able to utilize at any time. The exception here was that the sire of 06760's dam, A980167 had two great attributes we wanted to embed. He had the tightest downs type wool we'd seen in the APS flock, and in the severe drought like years in the early 2000s, 980167 handled those conditions and kept his muscling conformation better than our other rams at that time. He is 81% USA blood. Spider Status is being double checked to confirm clean status before sale.

Lot 16 – 60 doses (60 straws) (x3)

Advancer 090671 (AI) (84% USA Blood)

Comments: This ram presents an exciting combination of USA genetics. He was clearly the most outstanding ram lamb when that drop was weaned (see 2 photos). He is sired by A06760 (lot 15) but has an exciting outcross on the dam side: Cloud 246 bringing in extra length and frame, while he also carries "Giraffe" in his pedigree. He is 84% USA blood. Spider Status is being double checked to confirm clean status before sale.

The Blends (Combining the Bloodlines)

Lot 17 – 50 doses (50 straws)

Advancer 'Triple 7' 060777 (50% UK, 40% USA, 10% Aus)

Comments: "Triple 7" was the first of our top "blend" rams and had a big influence on our flock. He was a son of A040865 ET, one of the 100% UK rams we produced from the imported embryos that we used quite heavily, being out of Hans T79:P15, the highest measured performance ewe in the UK at the time of importation. "Triple 7" carries infusions of USA rams "Holwegner", "Supreme" and "The Ticket" on his dam side but was very UK in type and threw that way in the APS Flock. Very limited supply of his semen left - all included in this lot and lot 24.

Lot 18 – 20 doses (20 straws)

Advancer 'Perfect Blend' 080491 (50% USA, 41% USA, 9% Aus)

Comments: A080491 was named 'Perfect Blend' as he fitted our vision of the type of sheep we were trying to produce from the blend of these two exciting, but differing bloodline types. He had the UK power, bone and carcase conformation, combined with the refinement of shoulder and neck and outstanding body length of the USA type. He was used extensively within the flock and has also had an influence within a limited number of Australian flocks. (50% UK and 41% USA). Also, his grand dam (A 990099) was one of our very best breeding and donor ewes. Very limited semen reserves and all included in this lot and lot 24.

Lot 19 – 60 doses (60 straws) (x2)

Advancer 100509 (AI) (50% UK, 45% USA, 5% Aus)

Comments: When you've got something exceptionally good, being able to "double down" on it is a great option to have. That was the case in utilizing A040865 ET, the 100% UK son of Meikleson "Mighty Man" out of the highest measured performance ewe in the UK in 2003 (Hans T79:P15). Thus A100509 has A040865 ET as the sire of both his sire and dam. Throw in USA infusions of "Cloud" and "The Ticket" and we have a sheep with an absolutely outstanding pedigree, reflected in his physical structure, balance and type. (50% UK and 45% USA).

Lot 20 – 60 doses (60 straws) (x3)

Advancer 110603 ET (50% UK, 44%USA), 6% Aus)

Comments: A110603 ET is he last of our "blend" rams in this catalogue. He was our best non 100% "Mighty Man" son. However, like A930042 (lot 11) he wasn't used in the APS program as we were unsure of his Spider Syndrome status (known carrier "Giraffe" is sire of his grand dam), so he offers a unique package of 50% UK (all Mighty Man) and 44% USA blood, but displaying a stronger UK appearance and type. He is being re-tested to confirm Spider Syndrome clean status.

Comments: Glencraig 'Lucas' 121095 (15 doses), Wendenlea 990164 (15 doses), Taunton 941364 (15 doses), Pine Ridge 120/01 (12 doses) & Gypsum Hill 'Seaway' 116/86 (3 doses). Comments: This lot contains semen from five top rams; four of which are descendants from the APS program.

Glencraig "Lucus" 121095 – was ranked number 1 on Sheep Genetics Progeny Elites in 2014. He is linebred to Meikleson Mighty Man and was sold for \$4100 to Lynburn stud at the Northam Show & Sale in 2013.

Wendenlea 990164 – descends from A2939 (lot 13) on the dam side with some New Zealand bloodlines on the sire side. Regarded by Wendy Veitch as one of their best rams she produced and is still being used in several studs because of his exceptional eating quality traits.

Taunton 941364 – is the best A2439 sired son from Australian ewes that we saw in the first few years post quarantine release in 1992. He was too good not to ensure we got a package for security of the bloodline purposes.

Pine Ridge 120/01 – Champion Suffolk and interbreed champion shortwool ram at the 2002 Adelaide Royal and a descendant of A2439. This is the last of his semen we have.

Gypsum Hill "Seaway" 116/86 – Champion Suffolk ram Adelaide and Melbourne in 1987 (pre our importation). This is the last three doses of his semen known to exist, and while he has no imported blood, he is high quality and was used to reintroduce some Australian genetics into some blends.

Lot 33 - 60 doses

4 rams – 15 doses each – Glencraig 'Little George' 140297, Wendenlea 980223, Wendenlea 990149, Sueted 980715

Comments: Glencraig "Little George" 140297 – Carries Meikleson 'Mighty Man' (UK) on both the sire and dam sides of his pedigree. He sold to Lynburn Suffolk stud \$7,300 and later owned by 'Kirri' Suffolk stud. Wendenlea 980223 - a descendant of A2939 (lot 13) on the sire side. Wendenlea 990149 – a grandson of A2439 (lot 7). Sueted 980715 – a descendant of A2938 (lot 12) on the dam side, with NZ infusions.

Single Sire lots

Lot 41 – 60 doses (20 pellets) (x3)

Advancer 18890/90 Twin (AI) (37.5% USA)

Comments: Sired by the then Australian record priced White Suffolk ram, Elouera 'Eclipse', this was the top ram from our first drop of lambs for the Advancer White Suffolk flock program. Sold for \$15,000 to a syndicate of Renrut, Galaxy Park & Wilashben studs at release from quarantine in February 1992. Has bred exceptionally well as depicted by these photos of some of his APS grand sons and daughters.

Lot 42 – 30 doses (10 pellets)

Advancer 18922/90 Twin (AI) (50% USA)

Comments: Twin brother to 18921/90, sold to the Langley Heights & Cowobbee studs upon release from quarantine. From the same drop within quarantine as A18890, he was sired by Eclipse (Australian record priced White Suffolk ram at the time) and out of A2521/86 ET (100% USA Suffolk). The twin lambs pictured below were sired by A18922 out of an 11 month old paternal sister, with the lighter one (ram A19729/91) also used in the APS program. A18922 was used in this year's mating program and his last semen reserves are in this lot and the combination lot 48.

Lot 43 – 60 doses (20 pellets)

Advancer 930015 (ET) (62.5% USA)

Comments: A ram that had a significant impact in our early White Suffolk program, produced from our first ET drop post quarantine. Sired by BYU 'Supreme' 21T3 Tw, he offered us a white infusion from Elouera Eclipse 62/87 (Australian record priced White Suffolk ram when purchased) while also being 87.5% Suffolk and 62.5% USA blood; a unique combination.

Lot 44 – 60 doses (20 pellets)

Advancer 940098 (AI) (43.75% USA)

Comments: A940098 was a late spring drop lamb from our best White Suffolk ewe lamb in the flock at the time (A930018 Tw) and sired by Renrut 930257 ET. He carries 43.75% USA blood and was sold privately to Andrew Michael, Leahcim stud. The sire of the dam was Renrut Silver 940/90 that led the National Sire Progeny Test Scheme over the first three years.

Lot 45 – 30 doses (30 straws)

Advancer 070677 (AI) (50% USA)

Comments: A070677 was the main sire of our White Suffolk program for a few years, with a high percentage of our breeding ewes in the dispersal sale carrying some of his blood. He is 50% USA blood and was sired by A040869 ET, the very long and influential son of "The Ticket" (Imp USA Suffolk). The sire of the dam, A970045 was our first outstanding pure white son of A18890/90 (lot 41). This lot is this entire remaining semen reserve of A070677.

Lot 46 -60 doses (60 straws)

Advancer 090689 (AI) (41% USA, 12.5% Texel)

Comments: A son of A070677 (lot 45), A090689 was a valuable back up ram to his sire in our program, also offering a different outcross infusion of Texel blood through Carlsfield 930114, a ram that led the National Lambplan figures in the mid-1990s for overall recorded performance. 'Meatman' proved to be a very good whitener within the APS flock.
