# BUYERS GUIDE

## Scanned in-lamb Ewes

We are pleased to offer this selection of quality ewes; each ewe was scanned in lamb on Thursday, July 8<sup>th</sup> to a specific one of our specially selected Burrawang sires (refer to Joining Sires section below for more information). The number of foetuses detected at scanning is indicated as a single or twins within each lot listing, as is the date on which the ewe was inseminated.

Burrawang contracts scanning services from professional scanners. All ewes were rescanned by Barend Cronje and Trevor Pearce on July 20<sup>th</sup>. Pregnancy status information for lots 6, 13, 22, 89 and 97 has been updated in the catalogue and in online listings. All care is taken to provide accurate information about each ewe's pregnancy status however, we cannot guarantee lambing results.

## Animal Health and Bathurst Burr

To ensure the animals are healthy, all of them received Glanvac® 6 in 1 vaccination at tailing, weaning and at prescribed regular intervals including on February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021, at which time the ewes also received weight appropriate doses of Cydectin® Long Acting drench and of Multimin. Ewes on offer received a dose of Campyvax on March 8<sup>th</sup> and, as recommended, again on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Burrawang flock is Accredited Ovine Brucellosis Free; Certificate OB-TR expiring Feb 28, 2022.

Burrawang's OJD status is MN1; clear of OJD with certificate NS18176

Any purchased ewes to be delivered to South Australia, will be shorn prior to pick up or delivery to remove any Bathurst Burr.

## Pre-Sale Viewing

You're welcome to come to Burrawang (Ootha, NSW) to see the selection of ewes on offer. Please contact Mal Brady on 0428 500 027 by Saturday 5pm on July 17<sup>th</sup> to arrange a viewing. Viewing can be scheduled for Monday, July 19<sup>th</sup> or Thursday, July 22<sup>nd</sup> between 9am and 4pm. Travel to and from Burrawang must comply with current Covid regulations.

## Post Purchase Pick Up or Delivery Arrangements

*All purchases must be picked up from Burrawang West Station no later than 5pm on Tuesday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. All due care will be taken for the safety and health of your purchased ewes prior to pick up however, to protect your purchase, you may wish to consider insuring your ewes from the conclusion of the sale on July 23<sup>rd</sup>.*

## Ewe Typing

All ewes on offer were classed on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021, by well experienced, internationally qualified inspector, Philip van Schalkwyk. The result of Mr Van Schalkwyk's classing is indicated as T5 Stud, T4 Stud or T3 Commercial in accordance with the internationally recognised Dorper Breed Standard.

## Breeders' Comments

Burrawang's Stud Master, Wicus Cronje, has provided a comment about each ewe. His assessment is contained in Breeders' Comments within the Lot listing and as commentary on each Lot's video. Wicus is internationally recognised as one of the world's most experienced dorper breeders, inspectors and judges. He is a qualified inspector of The Dorper Breeders Society of South Africa and of Dorper Sheep Society of Australia and has over 40 years of experience as a dorper breeder in both countries.

### **BURRAWANG DORPER 170915 6GUN**

An eye-catching, stylish, high quality Dorper ram, 6GUN is big, strong, and amazingly easy moving. He breeds very appealing offspring with good balance, length, and a lot of muscle.

6GUN'S genetics are exceedingly rare outside of South Africa; his bloodline is 100% Cronje Dorpers (the longest continuously running dorper stud in the world). He is a proven sire who has earned extensive use in our stud breeding programs as he consistently breeds structural correctness into his ewe and ram offspring, most notably and unusually regarding feet and hooves. He is considered one of Australia's top breeding rams.

RODEO is impressively sound with a perfect topline, especially for the length of his body and the amount of meat he carries. He is a very well-balanced animal with a great head and remarkable outer twist.

RODEO and his offspring tick all the right boxes for growth and meat production, structural integrity, and free flowing movement. He is a "photocopier" of a breeding sire, creating extraordinarily consistent offspring.

### **BURRAWANG DORPER 191247 BEDROCK**

2021 Australian Champion Senior Dorper Ram, BEDROCK is such a special ram. With a pedigree like his, which draws on the Cronje/Mickey Phillips strengths via sire GREATMATE complimented by those of maternal grandsire BLINKI's Cronje/Global, it should come as no surprise. Structurally, he is unbelievable with an incredibly good topline and strong masculine head. He walks like a dream and has a genuinely nice temperament. Superior meat production capacity is evident in the depth of his brisket, his good sprung of rib, a deep flank, and width right through his body from shoulders to well-developed loins and broad rump.

Everything about BEDROCK suggests a lot can be expected from him in terms of breeding performance and quality and consistency of offspring. His first joining produced plenty of lambs which were born in Autumn 2021.

His first drop of lambs just hit the ground in April 2021 and confirm, not only his prowess, but his ability to consistently throw true to his breeding. A pedigree dominated by the best of Cronje and Mickey Phillips bloodlines working magic.

His very long body and rump, impressively well-developed muscling over his shoulders, back and loins, depth of flank, and good sprung of rib are nicely complimented by good body fat.

GREAT GUN's growth rate is remarkable. Structurally, he is very well balanced, stands nicely on all fours and walks beautifully. We are very much looking forward to his first drop of lambs due to arrive in the next few months!

2019 Australian Supreme Champion, PIET is a magnificent ram and an exceptional breeder. Several of his offspring have been selected for use as sires in BURRAWANG's stud breeding. Many of his ewe offspring are performing well and creating outstanding results as part of our stud flock.

PIET has a very strong head, is well balanced and breeds animals with excellent growth rates. He and his offspring scan exceptionally well in EMD (eye muscle depth) and shape; testament to the amount of meat he carries and that he breeds into his offspring.

Proven to survive and thrive with easy fluid movement, this ram's bloodline is well established in old, high quality South African genetics, most notably Kotze via The DOC.

## BURRAWANG WD 190525 FOSTERS

2021 Australian Champion Senior White Dorper Ram FOSTERS has an amazing presence and good temperament. The outstanding quality of his head tells the story of quality and good breeding. He has an amazing presence and good temperament. It all adds up to that WOW factor.

FOSTERS' sire, LOCO, produced several of BURRAWANG's white dorper sires, during his very short breeding time, before meeting an early demise in the paddock. On FOSTERS' dam side, grandsire CASPER was another prolific producer whose offspring topped their peer group in growth rates.

FOSTERS is extremely well balanced and, from end to end, is a standout. He has a particularly good, high quality head. His body is long, deep, and wide. He has well developed loins with an exceptionally long rump. The depth, quality, and muscle length of his hindquarter along with his ability to walk so easily, are hugely impressive.

His first drop of lambs is almost ready to wean, and we are keen to measure what our eyes tell us about this young sire's offspring!

## BURRAWANG WD 191427 TRUMP

At just 9 months old, TRUMP became the 2020 Australian Grand Champion White Dorper Ram. His striking carcass quality is the result of purposeful breeding designed to capture the outstanding meat producing capacity of animals on both sides of his bloodline. Blessed with a mix of Tien Jordan and THE DOC in his sire, TARZAN's pedigree and of KEG on his dam's side, TRUMP is a very masculine ram with exceptionally strong muscling in his shoulders, throughout his deep barrel and flank, and across well-developed loins and a long rump. At the same time, he has plenty of good body fat. Structurally, TRUMP is very correct on his feet and moves beautifully.

TRUMP's first lambs were born in Autumn 2021 and already demonstrate the same outstanding growth rate and carcass quality as TRUMP did even as a lamb.
