Don Pegler & Lyon Family, Oaklea Trust, Mt Gambier, SA

Don Pegler and Lyon family farm south of Mt Gambier right on the coast with free draining limestone and flint based soils, but are prone to very wet and windy conditions during lambing. Their commercial maternal wether lambs are sold as suckers at heavy trade weights through the Mt Gambier saleyards with the sister portion offered each year in the Cashmore Oaklea ewe sale.

These are June/July drop giving clients a little more weight and age and allowing an earlier mating from these well grown ewe lambs. These lambs are all bred from sound CFA ex stud ewes that have been pushed from the flock by higher performing daughters.

An entire drop of ex Stud ewes is also offered.



Jim, Andrea & Tom Pegler, Pegler Pastoral, Thornlea, SA

Pegler Pastoral Co have been breeding self replacing Cashmore Oaklea sheep since 2006. We farm at Thornlea and Kalangadoo in the south east of South Australia.

We lamb down in June/July, with lamb marking rates in 2022 being 165% for mature ewes and 150% for ewe lambs.

Only twin ewe lambs are retained as future breeders and all rams purchased are in the top 1% EBVs.

Our long term goals are to further increase our lambing percentages with earlier lambing and improve survival rates through genetic selection and improved management practices.



Rob Costin, Lochs Farming, Hordern Vale, VIC

Farming 1400ha at Hordern Vale and Apollo Bay, Lochs Farming is currently running 7000+ maternal composite and nudie ewes along with beef breeding and trading.

Run in 1100mm rainfall, the ewes consistently perform under high stocking rates and tough lambing conditions.

The genetic selections have focussed on high growth, EMD and Fat while maintaining an average mature body weight of 64kg in CS3.

The last two years have seen an average marking rate of 151% to mature ewes joined, with the majority of lambs sold at trade weights.



Dale & Jase Bateman, Kanangra, Furner, SA

Dale and Jase are a mixed cattle and sheep enterprise. After originally buying first cross ewes annually, we decided eight years ago to start buying in Cashmore Oaklea so we could self replace.

The flock is currently 1200 ewes with plans to grow the numbers.

We lamb down in late May through to June. Currently the lambing percentage is approximately 150% and has seen an increase over the past years.

All self replacing ewes are only kept out of scanned twin ewes.



RG & D Beck, Lynwood Park, Mingbool, SA

We first purchased a few composite Cashmore Oaklea ewes in 2011 and in addition 17 rams to put over our first cross ewes. It quickly became obvious that the increased fecundity and lamb survival, coupled with easy-care sheep with astounding growth rates made it possible for our business to expand rapidly.

Over the last 11 years we have bought an additional 2800 Cashmore Oaklea blood ewes and 145 rams to accelerate the move completely away from merino based first cross to higher performing sheep.



Josh Lilley, Carnham, VIC

Josh and Mel Lilley farm 12km north of Portfairy VIC, running self replacing material composites and cashmore nudies flocks in a wet invoiroment with a high stocking rate.

We have been purchasing Cashmore Oaklea rams for the past 6 years, selecting rams in the top 3% band for EBVs and have regularly been scanning 170-180% for a end of June / July lambing and are very happy with their hardiness and performance.

With excess numbers we will offer maternal and f1 nudie ewes lambs.



Justin Schultz, Lochaber, SA

I have been breeding self replacing meat sheep for 16 years, with this being my 10th year of Cashmore Oaklea bloodline. Cashmore Oaklea blood has brought greater growth, hardiness and a significant increase in twin survival.

I am going towards breeding Cashmore Nudies, so these ewe lambs include the best of my composites this year.

B&A Durcan, Compton, SA

For the previous 3 years Brian and Alyson have been purchasing Cashmore Oaklea ewe lambs from the studs or the top end breeders, and backgrounding them until 1.5y/o to suit breeders to joining early for an Autumn lambing.
