Edward Ringwood, Ringwood Ag, Woodside, SA

Ringwood Ag is a family run farming enterprise in the Woodside and Harrogate areas of the Adelaide Hills, The soils are predominately sandy loam over clay with rainfall ranging from 730mm to 550mm.

The current area farmed is 370ha owned and 170ha leased over which we are lambing down 3,600 ewes in a split lambing of Jul/Aug and Sep/Oct.

We've been purchasing exclusively Cashmore Oaklea Rams since 2011 and run a self replacing composite flock with only rams introduced to the property. Our focus has been on growth rates, milk, NLW, worm resistance and strong feet.



John and Brigita Keiller, Cashmore Park, Cashmore, VIC

Cashmore Park is a 1400 ha grazing property located 10km West of Portland, VIC, in a 830 mm rainfall zone. It runs 25.000 DSE with a 90: 10 sheep cattle mix.

The commercial flock consists of self replacing Performance Maternal ewes producing heavy trade carcasses, feeder lambs and breeding ewes. All ewes are pregnancy scanned with drys and wet/drys at marking sold. This action has produced fertile, free lambing easily managed sheep with adult ewes regularly pregnancy scanning 180%.

We offer August/September drop ewe lambs, some middle aged commercial ewes at client's request and a run of mostly ex Stud, sound mouth CFA ewes each year.



Ken and Carmen Varcoe, Terenga, Kalangadoo, SA

Terenga is located 40km south of Mt Gambier, 30 km East of Millicent near Kalangadoo in 800 mm rainfall zone. Terenga runs 2300 Cashmore Oaklea blood composite ewes. Initially purchasing ewes from Cashmore Park in 2006, subsequently purchasing Cashmore Oaklea rams in the top 10% (recently 5%) of the Maternal Index.

The focus at Terenga has been to produce hardy highly fertile ewes (140-150%) with good early growth and worm resistance that perform under high stocking rates. Terenga's program has been centred on producing large numbers of quality breeders for those seeking replacements.



Mike Riffkin & Simone Gloster, Hamilton, VIC

Mike and Simone run a self-replacing maternal composite sheep enterprise on a property 20km west of Hamilton. They started their Cashmore Oaklea flock in 2017 buying Cashmore Oaklea ewes from well-established Cashmore Oaklea vendors. Highly-ranked Cashmore Oaklea maternal sires have been purchased every year since 2017 with a focus on fertility, rapid lamb growth and worm resistance. The aim is to produce a low maintenance flock with high fertility and to constantly improve the quality and production of the flock through genetic and farm management advances.



Russell and Fiona Mitchell, Rusex Partnership, Glenthompson, VIC

Our farm is at Glenthompson in a 600 mm rainfall. We have been using only Cashmore Oaklea rams for the past 14 years, purchasing from the "elite" section of the catalogue. Due to the success of our self replacing maternal composites, we have decided to expand our operation and start supplying the replacement breeder market.

Our ram selection focus is on low birth weight, high early growth and keeping our adult weights down. This selection means our ewes are productive and easy care, producing high performance lambs that can be processed at 5 months of age. All this from adult ewes that only receive one drench per year.

In what has been a challenging year, the Cashmore Oaklea genetics have continued to perform, stand up and thrive.



Tom Casey, Willatook, VIC

Tom Casey runs a self replacing Maternal flock at Willatook NE of Port Fairy on heavy black flats and stony barrier country. It can be very wet in the winter and his stock are noted for how they come through hard times and are always presented well by a very good sheep man.

Abattoir production targets are heavy trade weight specifications from Maternal wethers and Poll Dorset sired lambs from older ewes. He has found the Cashmore Oaklea ewe lambs to be very fertile and offers pregnancy tested ewe lambs each July at 50 kg live weight.

Tom has supported this sale for a long time and sets up a good run of ewe lambs and 1.5 year olds each year which have been well received by purchasers. This year he is offering 100 1.5 YO.



Jeff and Jane Glare, Killara, Tarrone, VIC

Our farm is 20km north of Port Fairy. We run a 4000 head of self-replacing composite flock, in a wet environment with high stocking rates.

We join enough ewes to composite rams for replacements, with the balance to terminals.

We've been using Cashmore Oaklea rams for the past seven years and select mainly for hardiness and fertility, aiming for 140%+



R & L Manifold, Meekri, Weerite, VIC

The Meekri flock has been based on Cashmore Oaklea genetics exclusively for 8 years. The operation lambs down 7000 ewes in late July/August annually with focus on ewe fertility and fast lamb growth rates. Lambs are targeted at both processor and store markets with excellent results and positive past buyer feedback.



Tom & Fiona Fryar, Kangaroo Island Free Range Eggs, KI

The low maintenance Nudie ewes are a perfect fit for the Fryar family as they are busy with their free range egg farm and broad acre cropping program on Kangaroo Island SA Running a flock of 900 Self replacing Nudie's that were purchased from Cashmore Park in 2016 and have consistently purchased Nudie rams from Cashmore Park ever since. Lambing percentages have been in the vicinity of 155% lambing in July August. These shedders have handled our wet winter conditions very well, maintaining excellent hoof structure and health.



D & M Finnerty, Macarthur, VIC

I farm on four properties leased/owned in SW of VIC and SE of SA where I produce Angus calves and Nudie lambs. Numbers fluctuate depending upon market and environmental considerations but I usually run around 300 cows and 1200 nudie ewes in cold wet conditions.

I started buying Cashmore Nudie rams in 2010 and now have a fit for purpose, self replacing ewe flock which get the same management as the cattle; drench, vaccine, preg test and marking.

It's a simple system easily managed by one labour unit.



Nathan & Ashlee Lilley, Orford, VIC

Nathan and Ashlee Lilley with kids Ruby and Jack farm 19km north of Portfairy. Lambing down 1800 ewes in a wet environment at high stocking rates. All our ewes are 100% Cashmore Oaklea blood with foundation ewes being purchased as multiple born ewe lambs from cashmore park.

Only purchasing rams that index in the top 1%. With strong emphasis on WR, PWWT, MWWT. EMD & PFEC.

For the last 3 years only "twin born, twin bearing" ewe lambs have been retained as replacements. Offering excess ewe lambs as a large number of replacements kept last year.



James & Sarah Bull, Morgiana, VIC

James & Sarah have been running a small nudie flock since 2017 at Morgiana, south west of Hamilton. The flock was founded on Cashmore Nudie ex stud ewes, with top performing rams purchased annually with a focus on shedding, fertility and performance in wet conditions. The ewes have been managed with minimal inputs to develop a productive, easy care and resilient flock. Ewes are joined from mid-January, lamb easily and have shown outstanding lamb survival rates. The mature ewes are marking 140% with improving lamb weaning weights. Most lambs are sold at trade weight in early December.

Less than 10% of the ewes require any level shearing or crutching.

Nick Johns, St Johns, Rocklands VIC

Our entire flock is based on our original direct purchases of Oaklea and Cashmore ewe lambs from this very sale, 8 years ago. All rams bought have been in the top 5%, looking at worm resistance, bare breach and overall structure. We have built our flock to 7500 ewes and now have the opportunity to offer some surplus ewe lambs to the market.
