This Charolais draft are below breed average for Birth Weight, above average for all Growth, Carcase, Fat Cover and Marbling traits, which highlights our commitment to breeding high performing genetics.

ULTRABLACK

The Industries response to our Ultrablack program highlights the market acceptance of the breed across diverse climatic zones - Ultrablack now make up 70% of our total bull sales. I really believe we have only just scratched the surface for the potential this breed has in the Australian beef market.

Feedback has highlighted increases in fertility and carcase quality with no weight gain compromises, but it's the maternal strength added by retaining the Ultrablack or Ultrablack cross females that's proving to be even more valuable.

The Palgrove team have worked hard to present this draft of bulls. About Palgrove

The Palgrove stud is based in Warwick Qld, with our female herds located at Ben Lomond and Inverell, NSW. Our bull depot is located at Drillingham, QLD.

For over fifty years, we've adapted our Charolais genetics by committing to research, education, new technologies and a common sense 'cattleman's eye' to suit clients' environmental and management conditions. Palgrove now has the largest registered Charolais herd in Australia.

In 2009, we started developing our Ultrablack bull breeding program. We're positive that they offer another profitable option to our clients' production and target markets. Our bulls are grown out on pasture with moderate sale preparation. We believe a bull's career begins on sale day, so our sale bulls are presented to you ready to work.

AuctionsPlus

AuctionsPlus is an alternate bidding option if you can't attend the sale. However, it is only available to registered users. Please register online at least 24hrs prior to the sale.

Breeding Soundness

All bulls offered for sale have passed a semen test by Veterinarians, Ced or Adam Wise. The Vet will examine all bulls for structural and breeding soundness to Australian Veterinary Standards and will issue a Soundness Evaluation Certificate.

Supplementary Sheet

The bulls have scan data supplied by certified scanning technician, David Reid for Eye Muscle Area, Rump & Rib Fat, Marbling (IMF%) and will also have sale Weight and Scrotal Size measurements.

Guarantee

All bulls sold by Palgrove are guaranteed breeders. Any claim against the breeding ability of an animal purchased should be made in writing and accompanied by a Veterinary certificate within six months of the date of sale. If a bull fails to breed, it may either be replaced with an animal of comparable value or credit to the full purchase price will be given at any of Palgrove's auction sales or by private treaty.

Health

Palgrove maintains a J-Bas 7 status, so stock are free to move anywhere in Australia (please note WA eligibility).

All sale bulls have been inoculated twice with 7-in-1, Pestigard, Vibrio and 3 Day Sickness and 3 germ tick blood vaccinated.

Delivery

We take personal interest in the efficient delivery of all bulls after sale. The agents oversee all deliveries of sale cattle. We will assist in the delivery of bulls where possible in the Hunter Valley or on route to the Qld border via Tamworth.

The Markets

In our comments on most sale lots we've made some suggestions as to the most suitable market options for the progeny by the bulls. Some will fit a broad range.

Several factors influence the outcome of breeding, such as the breed makeup of your cows; seasonal conditions during the growth stage; country and management. In making these market suggestions, we consider a number of factors:

- Pedigree and EBVs
- Maturity type and growth pattern
- Physical attributes, like doing ability

We've always focused our breeding program on the commercial profit traits, but until now it was difficult to verify the value of Palgrove genetics - particularly for eating quality and the carcass \$ value that Palgrove genetics add.

Over the last few years, we've entered cattle in the Paddock to Palate competition which has enabled us to verify the profitability of Palgrove commercial progeny. Our cattle have risen to the top consistently with winning pens across weight gain, carcass and eating quality. We don't just make claims - we deliver value!

We've had the advantage of watching these bulls grow from birth and know their pedigrees like the back of our hand. As buyers you only get a couple of hours to make an assessment, so we encourage you to use our knowledge to help you select the right bull for your operation.

EBV's

In this sale, there are two separate BREEDPLAN figures presented:

- Charolais Group Breedplan
- Angus MBR Breedplan

We have included the latest Breedplan Data available to us before this catalogue went to print. For more information on accuracies and specific traits not included in this catalogue, visit the Charolais and Angus Society Websites at;

The Breedplan Data printed in this catalogue has been taken from the March 2022 (Charolais), and Mid April 2022 (Angus) run.

Each breed runs a separate BREEDPLAN evaluation. As the genetic base for each breed is different, only EBVs for animals within a particular breed can be directly compared.

Putting this in practical terms, a 600 day weight EBV of +41 on an Ultrablack bull is not equivalent to a 600 day weight EBV of +41 on a Charolais bull.

Our Ultrablack bull EBVs are provided to us as registered animals on the Angus Multi Breed Register (MBR). Only pure Angus cattle are recorded on HBR/APR registers.

We have not included the \$Indexes on our Ultrablack bulls as they are only relevant for purebred Angus genetic comparisons.

Perhaps we may even live long enough to see breed societies produce one single Breedplan report for all breeds.

When assessing cattle performance, it is essential to always compare 'apples' with 'apples'.

Therefore, we suggest you use the Angus Society EBV information provided in this catalogue to assess the Ultrablack bulls as a contemporary group only (ie. compare Palgrove bull to Palgrove bull within this sale).

We have been careful to select predictable Brangus and Angus breeding sires from commercially focused herds with high accuracy Breedplan data.

Performance data:

We see the most sustainable genetic gain being achieved by using practical, commonsense physical selection alongside objective performance data to ensure the best bulls are produced for the next generation.

Our Ultrablack bull EBVs are provided to us as registered animals on the Angus Multi Breed Register (MBR). Only pure Angus cattle are recorded on HBR/APR registers.

When assessing cattle performance it is essential to always compare 'apples' with 'apples'.

Therefore, we suggest you use the MBR Angus EBV information provided in this catalogue to assess the Ultrablack bulls as a contemporary group only (ie. compare bull to bull within this sale).

Note: If required, any of our bulls can be registered on the Brangus Society's Enrolment Register.

Palgrove is fast becoming a leading supplier of Ultrablack genetics in Australia. We now sell over 500 Ultrablack bulls a year with production continuing to expand annually.

Our Ultrablack breeding program continues to develop, and we now have a larger percentage of generationally bred Ultrablacks (UB4s and UB5s)

Reports from our clients have been overwhelmingly positive - "the heifer progeny mature at an earlier age and fertility percentages have risen markedly".
