We would like to welcome you to our 5th on property ram sale and thank you for your ongoing support.

We have had another busy year with the stud and have certainly enjoyed life getting back to normal following the pandemic. Shows were back on this year and we have continued our involvement with the Gilgandra High School's Livestock Show Team. The students helped to prepare and exhibit our show team both at a number of local shows and the NSW State Sheep Show in Dubbo. Their excellent help enabled us to take a larger team to the shows attended and we have been so proud of their commitment and enthusiasm throughout the show season.

We have continued to seek out new genetics for our flock with two ram purchases made from the Bindaree and Tenalba Border Leicester Studs. We have also been lucky enough to purchase a number of ewes from the Tenalba stud as part of their dispersal and look forward to seeing how these new genetics influence our flock.

Following on from the positive feedback received last year we have decided to continue to interface our sale with AuctionsPlus moving forward. Videos of all lots will be available to view on the AuctionsPlus website in the lead up to the sale or alternatively inspections of rams on property can be arranged at a time that suits you.

Following on from a tradition started at 'Johnos Border Leicesters', this year we will also begin to donate the proceeds of Lot 1 to a charity. This year we have chosen these funds to be donated to the Royal Flying Doctors Service. Although we hope to never require their services we take much comfort knowing their lifesaving help is available should we need it.

Our flock is performance recorded through Lambplan with a focus on selecting for animals with excellent reproduction (WR), maternal (MWWT), carcase (PFAT, PEMD) and growth traits (WWT, PWWT). The ASBV information displayed in our catalogue has been calculated in the 15th of August Lambplan analysis. All efforts have been made to ensure we provide accurate data both in the analysis and this catalogue.

You will notice in the catalogue the old Number of Lambs Weaned (NLW) trait has been replaced with the new Weaning Rate (WR) trait. Further information on the this change and its impact on the BLX index can be found on the following page. You may also notice a note under a couple of rams that have a new physical ID tag, when lotting we replaced a few NLIS tags that had broken to ensure the boys have the correct tag to leave the property. Their Sheep Genetics ID is however their original tag number as shown under ID.

The Border Leicester Cross Index shown in our catalogue has been developed to suit a production system using BL sires crossed to merino dams producing 1X progeny. It has a strong emphasis on fertility, maternal and early growth traits whilst capping adult ewe weight.

We have maintained our health status of OB Accredited Free and OJD rating of MN2- Vaccinated for added peace of mind.

Inspections will open at 11am with the Auction to commence at 1pm. Please also join us for lunch from 12pm and a beer after the sale. Delivery on rams purchased can be arranged, please speak with us after the sale if required.

Updates to the BLX Index

Number of Lambs Weaned (NLW) has been replaced by an improved ASBV called Weaning Rate (WR). This new ASBV has been included in the BLX index.

Sheep Genetics has released a new trait that measures reproductive performance called Weaning Rate (WR). WR combines the traits of Conception (CON), Litter Size (LS) and Ewe Rearing Ability (ERA) into a single ASBV for selection. From 2022 onwards WR has replaced the previous trait of Number of Lambs Weaned (NLW) and has been included in the BLX index.

As a result of the introduction and inclusion of WR in the BLX index there have been changes in the percentiles for the analysis. You may notice that the 50th percentile for the analysis has changed compared to last year.

This ram sale season it will be important to use the percentile band table to re-benchmark what the percentiles are to assist with ram purchasing decisions.

SuperBorders is the brand name for Border Leicester Rams that are of high genetic merit for a first cross production system. The official SuperBorder yellow ear tags allow SuperBorder rams to be easily identified.

To qualify as a SuperBorder a Border Leicester ram must be above the 50th percentile for the breed based on the BLX index (Border Leicester Cross Index). The 50th percentile index value is calculated based on the 15th of August LAMBPLAN run each year. It is used to determine SuperBorder rams for that selling season. The BLX Index has been developed for production systems using Border Leicester sires crossed to Merino dams to produce first cross progeny. BLX balances maintaining mature size with significant improvements in early growth and reproduction. A higher BLX index targets animals that are more profitable in this production system.


Not all rams sold by SuperBorder members are necessarily SuperBorder quality, but are bred by committed, registered breeders striving for genetic gain. SuperBorder rams must be structurally sound and of good breed type.
