Jarrah is a family-owned and hands on operated cattle breeding business committed to providing the most relevant, efficient and market orientated genetics to the Australian Beef Industry. Jarrah Genetics, our bull breeding enterprise is a result of this policy and focusing on the superior genetics with proven records to enhance performance and predictability.

We offer 3 lines of genetics in:

- / **Herefords** - polled. Acclimatised to Central Queensland.
- / **Redfords** - a pure red animal that is a minimum 25% Jarrah Hereford and remaining percentage Red Brahman.
- / **Jarrah Reds** 'the clean-coated flatbacks' are a blend between our Redford genetics and Santa Gertrudis.

The genetics we offer stems from our philosophy that Australia's global market advantage is and will be grass-fed beef. A type of animal that has the ability to finish off grass also excels in a short-fed grain program, an area

where Australia's production has expanded in recent years.

In the bull breeding program, we focus on producing genetics with carcasses that have commercial relevance. On top of this, traits such as temperament, structural correctness, udder shape, milking performance and fertility are selected for. The genetics are backed with generations of calving ease traits and fertility. Each herd has a short joining period and a strict cull of the pregtested empties is adhered to.

We see our real strength as the fact we run a vertically integrated beef program. This means we cover and are exposed to everything from seed stock production through to the commercial end product. Jarrah Cattle Company is our commercial breeding and backgrounding operation. By growing cattle through to the end product it ensures we have a commercial slant in the Jarrah program.

THE JARRAH 'BUY BACK' SCHEME

At Jarrah we run a commercial breeding operation utilising our own genetics and also background cattle. Part of the backgrounding operation is offering a 'buy back' scheme. We stand behind our genetics and prefer to source weaners with our genetics. It adds further traceability for the genetics and also allows a floor to be put in the market for clients' selling program. WELCOME

WE HAVE COINED 2022 AS A YEAR OF GROWTH. FOR US IT HAS MEANT GROWING AS A FAMILY AND A BUSINESS. FOR THE INDUSTRY IS HAS MEANT CONTINUING GROWTH IN THE NATIONAL CATTLE HERD AND GROWTH IN LAND PRICES.

Perhaps the most important growth for 2022 is the growth in our bull numbers for the annual Jarrah Genetics bull sale! This year we are proud to be presenting our largest offering of both Hereford and Jarrah Red bulls to date, and we are confident that they are our strongest draft yet.

The past few years we have commented on how strong the cattle market and broader agricultural industry have been, and this year is no exception. In April, we saw the EYCI reach a new all time record, feedlots have been operating at high capacities, and despite the hardships throughout the supply chain beef prices have managed to remain strong. The continued emergence of new global markets, combined with an increasing supply as the national herd rebuilds, gives us confidence that the Australian beef industry will remain in good stead to capture new opportunities moving forward.

More broadly in agriculture we have also seen growth in the mindset of the producer. We have seen operations become increasingly progressive, making significant investment in both water infrastructure as well as the development of land, to increase productivity and mitigate the ramifications of marginal seasons moving forward. All huge steps in the sustainability of our industry.

From our perspective, it has been rewarding to see how people's investments in our genetics have been paying off for their operations. Making an investment in new sires should never be underestimated, as this is setting up a herd for years to come. The feedback we receive on increased fertility results with heifers, as well as steers hitting market specs quicker from using Jarrah bulls, gives us confidence in our breeding program.

'BRED TO PERFORM' - COMBINING PERFORMANCE AND PHENOTYPE.

'Bred to Perform' is a motto that we have come up with to underpin our breeding program at Jarrah. It is based around the concept of combining performance with phenotype, to ensure we are producing the most commercially relevant genetics to progress our operation and yours. All too often we see breeders going one sided when considering these traits, we aim to maintain both to produce optimal genetics that are suitable, relevant, and efficient.

Focusing on phenotype, ensures that the cattle we breed have the constitution, structural correctness and soundness needed to handle Queensland conditions and meet market specifications. A focus on performance and incorporating the use of EBVs, ensures greater efficiencies for the producer and an operation. For us, this encompasses creating fertility pressures through yearling heifer joinings, having short, controlled joining periods and by setting benchmarks for things such as scrotal development amongst each draft of bulls. Further to this weight gain benchmarks ensures that steers and surplus heifers reach market specifications in the quickest time possible, to allow for an efficient and consistent turn off.

It is our philosophy, that by having 'Bred to Perform' in the front of our minds with every decision, we can offer you bulls with genetics that not only look the part and are suited to the environment but have depth of performance behind them. All of this helps to make your investment safer.

We are very proud of this line of bulls and believe them to be representative of these ideals. We look forward to welcoming you to inspect our draft of 2022 sale bulls.

2022 JARRAH RED BULLS

This year we are offering the pick of 3 drops of bulls, with the addition of yearlings into the draft.

This decision came about after trialling the use of yearling bulls in our own operation last year. It is safe to say they superseded our expectations; continuing to grow out nicely and achieving great pregnancy-test results. After this year's sale it is our intention to only offer two year old and yearling bulls. We believe this adds benefits to you as clients, being able to source our most advanced genetics 12 months earlier and by allowing bulls to better acclimatise from a younger age. Further information on using yearling bulls can be found later in the catalogue.

We believe this draft of bulls represents not only our best line of Jarrah Red bulls, but also our most consistent to date. Perhaps most exciting for us is that when walking from the opening to the closing pen of bulls we really feel like you can see where our program is headed. The bulls throughout the draft show tremendous muscle expression and carcass with length and bone. We are particularly impressed with the level of early development the yearling bulls are showing, giving us further confidence in offering them to you for sale.

Amongst the draft is a combination of exciting new sires, as well as the continuation of strong proven lines. Sons of Jarrah Red 421 (H) continue to demonstrate that extreme length, softness and impeccable temperament that we love to see. Emerging sire lines like Jarrah Red 8283 (S) and Jarrah Red 8247 (H) offer power and performance in the extreme. Extra hardiness is offered through the sleek coats of the Jarrah Red 9150 (S), Jarrah Redford N125 (PP) and Jarrah Redford N250 (S), while sires like Jarrah Red 431 (P), Jarrah Red 326 (S) and Jarrah Red 403 (S) continue to offer natural thickness and versatility to an operation.

The clean-coated flatbacks

A blend between our Redford genetics and Santa Gertrudis. The Redfords are pure red cattle with a minimum 25% Jarrah Hereford and the remaining percentage Red Brahman. This, combined with the Santa Gertrudis results in an animal with approximately 46% British component.

They are designed to be a type of animal that fits the bill of a 'clean-coated flatback'. The Jarrah Reds are stabilised, producing large lines of females and bulls that are consistent. Consistency gives confidence to producers when selecting Jarrah Red genetics.

ABOUT JARRAH REDS

- / Bred to be a low maintenance, high performing breeding option
- / Clean coats make them more tick resistant, heat tolerant and extremely hardy
- / Genetics backed with fertility, with breeders having a fixed joining period and pregested to eliminate the PTEs
- / Strong focus on carcass, doing ability and temperament
- / British component provides many benefits with carcass quality such as fat coverage and marbling
- / Emphasis is placed on udders, milking ability and overall structural correctness
- / These attributes combine to ensure that a commercially viable animal is produced

2021 SALE

Jarrah Reds averaged \$13,030 selling to a high of \$18,000 at the 2021 Jarrah Genetics sale, Banana.

It was an unseasonably brisk day at Glenarchy, Banana, but this didn't deter the crowds from attending the Becker family's ninth annual Jarrah Genetics bull sale. Records for the stud were achieved in both breeds, reaching the highest top price and average across both the Hereford and Jarrah Red drafts of bulls.

Thirty three Jarrah Reds sold to set a \$13,030 average and topped at \$18,000, resulting in an overall \$4243 boost to last year's sale result.

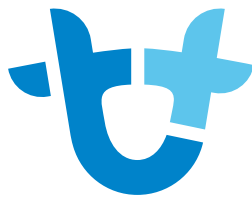

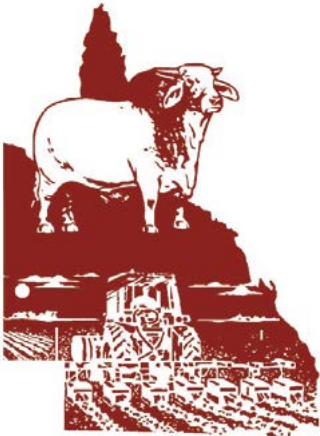

Introducing Jarrah Red EBVs

Jarrah Reds are now registered on the Tropical Breedplan database. We are now able to offer EBVs on each of the sale bulls, to provide another tool in bull selection. We have utilised Breedplan in the Hereford herd for some time, and have experienced the benefits that EBVs bring. With the inclusion of large amounts of data over generations we have seen great increase in the accuracy of this information. This is the start of the journey with EBVs for the Jarrah Reds.

Whilst other breeds are on the Tropical database, accurate comparisons can only be made with other Jarrah Red animals. We recommend ranking the bulls as to where they fit within the sale draft.

An animal's breeding value is its genetic evaluation, half of which will be passed on to its progeny. These estimates are called Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs).

In the calculation of EBVs, the performance of individual animals within a contemporary group is directly compared to the average of other animals in that group. A contemporary group consists of animals of the same sex and age class within a herd, run under the same management conditions and treated equally. Indirect comparisons are made between animals reared in different contemporary groups, through the use of pedigree links between the groups.

The absolute value of any EBV is not critical, but rather the differences in EBVs between animals. Particular animals should be viewed as being "above or below breed average" for a particular trait.

Whilst EBVs provide the best basis for the comparison of the genetic evaluation of animals reared in different environments and management conditions, they can only be used to compare animals analysed within the same analysis. Consequently, Jarrah Red EBVs cannot be compared with EBVs for any other breed.

AN OUTLINE OF THE DIFFERENT EBVS

Birth Weight EBV (kg) (BW) the lower the EBV value, the lighter the calf at birth.

200-Day Growth EBV (kg) (200 Wt) indicates the relative weight advantage of a sire at 8-10 months.

400-Day Weight EBV (kg) (400 Wt) indicates the relative weight advantage of a sire at yearling age.

600-Day Weight EBV (kg) (600 Wt) the best single estimate of an animal genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Mature Cow Weight EBV (kg) (Mat Cow) an estimate of the genetic difference in cow weight at 5 years of age.

Milk EBV (kg) (Milk) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV indicates the effect of the daughter's milking ability, inherited from the sire, on the 200-day weights of her calves. For dams, it indicates her own milking ability.

Scrotal Size EBV (cm) (Scrotal) is calculated from the circumference of the scrotum taken. This EBV is an estimate of an animal's genetic merit for scrotal size.

Carcase Weight EBV (kg) (Carcase Wt) is based on abattoir carcass records and is an indicator of the genetic differences in carcass weight at the standard age of 650 days.

Eye Muscle Area EBV (sq cm) (EMA) positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals. Sires with higher EMA EBVs are expected to produce better muscled progeny.

Fat EBV (mm) (Rib) (Rump) are calculated from measurements of subcutaneous fat depth at the rib and rump (from live animal ultrasound scans). Sires with a low, or negative, fat EBV are expected to produce leaner progeny at any particular carcass weight than will sires with higher EBVs.

Retail Beef Yield EBV (%) (RBY) indicates genetic differences between animals for retail yield percentage in a standard 300 kg carcass. Sires with larger EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat EBV (%) (IMF) positive EBVs indicate likelihood of more intramuscular fat.

Accuracy (%) (ACC%) accuracy indicates the "confidence level" of the EBV. The higher the accuracy value the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV with addition of more performance records on the animal.

Jarrah Calving Periods

At Jarrah we have two calving periods. The two calving periods are run separately and the same fertility pressure is ensured. This year we will have three age group of bulls, autumn bulls (26-28 months), spring bulls (21-24 months) and yearling autumn bulls (14-16 months). This will be the last time we will be offering the older autumn bulls, moving forward we will only have the spring and autumn yearling bulls in the sale.

We have always kept the best bulls for the bull sale to give equal opportunity for purchase, hence we retained the lead autumn bulls (26-28 months) and the remainder were sold through the paddock.

THIS YEAR WE WILL BE OFFERING A RUN OF 17 YEARLING BULLS. THE DECISION TO OFFER YEARLING BULLS COMES FROM A RANGE OF REASONS, THE MAIN BEING, WE ARE ABLE TO OFFER OUR NEWEST GENETICS SOONER.

Last joining season, we used several yearling bulls in our own operation to trial the performance of this age group of bulls, being joined to both heifers and cows. After these yearling bulls performing remarkably well on both pregnancy test results and the performance, we decided to now offer yearlings for your selection.

Whilst yearlings may not grow out to their full genetic potential, acclimatising earlier has been proven to increase their working life because of super fitness and lower levels of body fat. We urge you to keep these factors in mind when considering the yearling draft.

YEARLINGS BECOMING POPULAR

In Australia there is a trend towards using bulls at yearling age (12-18 months). This allows introduction of superior genetic material into herds a year earlier than normal, resulting in faster genetic improvement. By using genetically superior bulls as young as possible, faster turnover rates of genes are achieved.

Their introduction has the potential to allow breeders to extend the working lives of bulls by a year or more, lowering the bulls costs of a herd. This extra workload is achieved at the time in their lives when they are young, lean, fit and exuberant. They are free of the structural problems that beset older bulls.

Yearling bulls have much to offer, both genetically and financially.

WHY USE YEARLINGS?

Cattle producers with experience in managing yearlings often say that they prefer them because they settle in better, mix with other cattle more easily and are easier to handle than older bulls. However, there are some far more tangible incentives in using them.

By first using bulls as yearlings, the working life of a bull can be extended by a year or more. In addition to this advantages, there is strong circumstantial evidence to suggest that bulls used first as yearlings have even longer working lives because of superior fitness and lower levels of body fat. The more active lives of these bulls means that they are maintained at body weights below their genetic potential. As a result, less stress is placed on their skeletal structure when serving, with less likelihood of breakdowns occurring.

WILL YEARLING BULLS BE SEXUALLY MATURE?

British breed yearling bulls will generally be sexually mature if they:

- / are well grown
- / are in good condition (fat score of high 2 or low 3)
- / are 12 months of age or older

SERVING ABILITY

Yearling bulls are usually sexually inexperienced. As a result, they are sometimes, but not always, a little clumsy and awkward. However, young bulls have very steep learning curves. This learning phase may cause minor delays in the start of calving. Should this be a problem, joining should start 7 or 14 days earlier than normal to compensate for the slight delay.

MATING MANAGEMENT

Yearling bulls can be effectively joined either individually or in peer groups. They should not be joined in a group with older bulls because of 'dominance'.

The use of yearling bulls is limited only by their health and fitness. A lot of common sense is needed in order to strike a balance. It does not matter whether they 'won't grow out' as it's just not relevant. If our beef industry is to make progress, we must purge our minds of the belief that a bull has to be fat and well grown to be any good. The value of a bull should be measured by the performance of his offspring—not on what he looks like.

A more conservative approach is needed in the first year, until you have a track record for the performances of yearling bulls on your farm. In these situations, mating loads of only 25-30 females are recommended.

WON'T YEARLING BULLS HAVE SMALLER CALVES?

There is no relationship between the age of a bull at joining and the weights of his calves.

The birthweight of calves is heritable, so a bull will influence, genetically, the birthweight of his calves. If you are concerned about birthweight, buy a bull that has a low estimated breeding value (EBV) for birthweight, or one that had a lower birthweight than the average of other bull calves in the same drop.

SUMMARY

- / Try to avoid single sire mating at all times, no matter the bulls age, and ideally join yearlings with bulls same age in the group to avoid injury
- / Yearlings can handle between 25-40 females at one time, but the bigger the cows, reduce the size of group per bull, we would recommend in their first year 30 females per bull
- / Bulls can lose condition after joining, but recover to normal weight in time. Post joining diet overcomes this and the bulls generally remain lean and fit for longer
- / Keep an eye on the bulls during joining if you can
