

GLENLEA CHAROLAIS

Glenlea will celebrate 45 years of breeding Charolais in 2016.

The stud was graded up from Angus, Shorthorn and Devon base cows with introductions of Full French females from bloodlines in New Zealand in the 1970s. The type developed by the Binny Family is a high performance, well-muscled Charolais on a medium frame with early gestation, and the critical trait of crossbred progeny of our bulls being able to finish on grass at domestic weights.

The herd having evolved in Tasmania over 40 plus years where very little feed lotting happens and so the vast majority of cattle are grass and crop finished, has resulted in a type that is different to the majority of Northern NSW and Queensland Charolais. Through extensive performance recording over the last 28 years we have been able to select for increased performance along with as much muscling as we can while maintaining calving ease, as gestation length is an often over looked trait in this quest, by eliminating the later gestation bloodlines you eliminate 99% of calving ease issues. The result may have some birth weight but the calves are born easily and with excellent vigour.

Our record of Show Champions, carcass competitions, grass fed steer performance trials continually allowed us to benchmark our cattle's performance and growth curves to refine our breeding strategy, this process is ongoing breeding cattle to suit today's markets.

Our polled breeding program started in the mid 1980's with the purchase of "DINO". His semen was exported to Canada, USA and several other countries, only the second Australian Bred Charolais bull to have semen exported at the time.

Today we are proud to present our polled Charolais bulls with all the growth and carcass quality with the ever important criteria of being good doers under tough conditions and fatten quickly to market following seasonal breaks.

Our first E.T. program was conducted in 1981 when the process was still being developed and we have been involved in E.T. programs ever since. Nearly all our current herd of females are from E.T.

With a major sale of the aged breeder herd in 2007 and the sale of the Tasmanian properties the framework for a move to NSW was laid.
