Born on or after 30 October 2014 & before 28 February 2015

Over 18 months & not over 20 months Min 600kg

Born on or after 30 August 2014 & before 30 October 2014

Over 20 months & not over 30 months Min 700kg

Born on or after 30 October 2013 & before 30 August 2014

Over 30 months & not over 36 months Min 800kg

Born on or after 30 April 2013 & before 30 October 2013

Stud Females

Over 12 months & not over 22 months

Born on or after 30 June 2014 & before 30 April 2015

Joined or unjoined but assured breeders with vendor guarantee

Over 22 months and not over 30 months PTIC with vet certificate

Born on or after 30 October 2013 & before 30 June 2014

Born on or after 30 October 2013 & before 30 June 2014

Over 30 months PTIC with vet certificate
Born before 30 October 2013 and/or calf at foot

Weaned

Minimum 7 months of age

Minimum 230kg

Minimum 50% Speckle Park blood

Must be able to tie up

Commercial F1 Females

Pens of 3-5 animals

Beef breed X Speckle Park (i.e. minimum 50% Speckle Park and no dairy)

Speckle Park sires must be preferably registered or at a minimum be "registerable"

Vendor must be able to demonstrate ability to verify sire

Sire pedigree to be included on entry form

Embryos and Semen

Maximum 3 x packages in total per vendor

Maximum 10 x straws per semen package

Embryos must be "A Grade" and collected by registered technician with certificate

Embryos must be parent verifiable

Vendors must have minimum one live Stud animal in sale

Sale Committee to approve all genetic lots

ENTRY FEES:

Commercial Show Calves (Steers and Heifers)	\$50 per head
Commercial F1 Female Pens (3 – 5 animals)	\$200 per pen
Stud Animals (Bulls and Females)	\$200 per head
Semen	\$50 per lot
Embryos	\$150 per lot

CONDITIONS OF SALE:

- Bulls will require mandatory Vet checks. These will be the responsibility of the vendor and are to be carried out within 60 days prior to the sale.
- Each bull will need the Veterinary Association's standard minimum testicle size and structural soundness certificate to accompany the bull to the sale.
- SPI Inc. strongly recommends that each bull be semen and fertility tested allowing the vendor to display this important information to prospective purchasers.
- Females 12 to 22 months can be joined or unjoined but assured breeders with vendor guarantee of breeding soundness for six months.
- Females 22 to 30 months must be PTIC with vet certificate
- Females over 30 months with a calf at foot can be PTIC or not.
- Females over 30 months with no calf at foot must be PTIC with vet certificate.
- All animals will be weighed and inspected by an independently appointed Vet to ensure are fit for sale and meet the minimum criteria at a cost of \$15 per animal payable by the vendor.
- Black stock are eligible for the sale.
- All live stud animals must be registered with SPI Inc.
- AGENT: MacCallum Inglis is the Agent employed for the sale. They will charge 6.0% commission plus usual yard fees and dues payable by the vendor.
- Sale will be via Auction.
- Sale will be held at the Scone Selling Centre, Scone, NSW (Saleyards).
- All animals to be at the Selling Centre by 1pm Friday 29th April.
- If vendors wish to deliver animals prior to Friday 29th April, please contact the appointed agent directly on 02 6545 1211.
- All registered animals are to have clearly legible tattoos (including calves at foot).
- All calves at foot must be eligible for registration with SPI Inc.
- All registered animals (including calves) are to be tested for Pestivirus and certified as non-PI.
 Certificate of testing will be required.
- SPI Inc. recommends that animals are tick fever vaccinated for the Queensland market.
- Entries form(s) and fees are due in by <u>Friday 15th January 2016</u>. No refund will be given for withdrawn lots. Withdrawn animals can be replaced with an alternate animal. Alternate animals must meet <u>ALL</u> entry requirements.
- COPY OF CERTIFICATE OF CURRENCY FOR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE must have the clause "Situation: Anywhere in Australia".

The entry form must be accompanied by payment, insurance certificate and animal details.

Arrival at the Sale venue must be accompanied by Vet Certificate and Pestivirus Certificate.

The Sale Committee
