ROSELEA Merino Stud - History

Roselea Merino Stud was founded in 1936 by T.A.Hacker on Bundemar and Haddon Rig bloodlines. The sheep produced were well nourished 64S quality medium wools.

Through the 1950's and 60's only Haddon Rig and Uardry sires were used. Pooginook blood was added in the early 80's.

The Roselea Poll Stud was established in 1957 on Success and Reno blood. Some Poll Boonoke and Eudora sires were added in the 1980's.

In the early 90's Peter Hacker became Roselea Studmaster. Since then Billandri and Willemenup blood has been added to the polls and more Haddon Rig and Uardry to the Merinos.

Over recent years size and body weight of the sheep has been given higher priority and a greater emphasis has been placed on softness of the wool. These measures have resulted in a lowering of the micron by nearly 2 microns over the past 23 years without the loss of fleece weight.



EXPLANATION OF TERMS

MIDSIDE SAMPLE

The midside sample is generally the accepted region for sampling individual animals. The midway between belly and back line and around the third rib area.

MICRON

The mean fire diameter of all fibres measured.

<u>SD</u>

Standard deviation - a measure of dispersion of individual results. Standard deviation is expressed in the units of measurement.

CV%

The co-efficient of variation of fibre diameter. It is expressed as a percentage of standard deviation and mean fibre diameter. Figures less than 29% are desirable. The lower the better.

COMFORT

Comfort Factor. % of fibre above 30 micron = 100%

Comfort Factor. Above 95% - Desirable. Comfort Factor. Above 98% - Excellent

BODY WT

Actual Live Body Weights = Kgs.

COMMENTS

Measurements are influenced by the age of the sheep, the site from which the sample is taken, the length of the wool (wool growth) and nutrition. We recommend that when selecting your rams you take these factors into consideration and combine this information with balanced "hands-on" approach.
