

#### Look no further than Valley Vista

If you are looking for Poll Dorset rams which will produce lambs for every market then you should look no further than the Valley Vista stud. The Valley Vista Poll Dorset stud was founded in 1976 and moved from its original home at Burrumbuttock, New South Wales, to Coolac, NSW in 1990. The stud was expanded in 1991 when Valley Vista stud principals Andrew and Donna Scott purchased the entire Meadow Creek stud from the late Ernie Britt. There was further expansion for the stud in November 2006 when the Scotts purchased 550 ewes and stud sires from the Gererdan stud, which at the time was among the top studs in Australia. In 2008 Joe, James and Luke Scott founded the Valley Vista Park stud with the purchase of 18 stud ewes at the Kismet dispersal sale. The Scotts have continued to add to their genetic base over the years with purchases of genetics from the Armdale, Armdale Park, Tattykeel, Hillden, Kurralea, Graythorn, Springwaters and Derrynock studs. Combined the studs have built the numbers up to approximately 1000 stud ewes. This provides good numbers to select from, allowing the stud to cull heavily

When selecting rams for their stud's breeding program the Scott's have placed emphasis on traits such as ease of lambing and high growth rates. They also place emphasis on producing a well-muscled and structurally correct sheep. One of the main selection criteria is selecting for high growth rate. All lambs are weighed at weaning and then twice more at thirty day intervals. These weights are converted to grams/day. Lower than 300 to 350 grams/day are culled. The lambs doing better than 300 to 350 grams/day (depending on the season) are retained in the stud. The stud also scans all rams, using Stockscan, for muscle area and individual data on each animal. Scans are also combined with further data recorded on-farm to produce up-to-date Lambplan figures.

The family and the flock continue to grow with an increased number of stud lambs hitting the ground this year, building numbers up on the back of consecutive good seasons. We've also increased the number of on-property sales, adding a January auction and including ewes in the offering. What has decreased is the age they are turning off rams, moving more in-line with their clients needs and industry markets. A majority of the rams offered at Valley Vista are now 12 months old or younger, which has been well received by their commercial clients, a majority of which use them over Merino ewe flocks. The younger aged rams now give clients a better opportunity to utilise the very best genetics. It also gives them a chance to see the early development of the sheep, which is what they are after when breeding for the sucker lamb market.

Valley Vista held its inaugural summer sale in January 2022, offering 2021 spring-drop rams at just nine to 10 months, as well as a selection of mixed-age scanned-in-lamb stud ewes. The results achieved from both were above expectation, and showed it was a step in the right direction - we sold a total clearance of 38 ewes to a top price of \$3600, averaging \$1978, and all 88 rams for an average of \$2685, topping at \$4600 twice. The strength of ewe sale was a particularly strong vindication of Valley Vista's breeding objectives, and sire selections, with most SIL to their new \$32,000 ram Tattykeel 200240.

Valley Vista has been involved in the Poll Dorset Research Flock, Bowan Park, for the past few years, and in 2021 nominated our homebred sire Valley Vista 200086, as well as a sire we purchased in 2018 and have used widely in the stud, Tattykeel 170400. The trial collected carcass data from 12 lambs per sire in 2021, including intramuscular fat (IMF) levels - a measure of the chemical fat percentage in the loin muscle of a lamb, and the visible marbling. IMF impacts the eating characteristics of lamb, including flavour, juiciness, tenderness and overall liking. The two rams entered by Valley Vista in the Bowan Park trial sired lambs with the highest average IMF percentages of the cohort - 4.77 per cent and 4.98 per cent. The industry mean average at the time of collecting the data was 4.3 per cent. Valley Vista also has two sires in this year's Bowan Park cohort, in Valley Vista 210006 and Valley Vista Park 210002, and look forward to seeing their results.

Valley Vista had their best year yet in the show ring in 2022, exhibiting the Poll Dorset Champion of Champions ram (VV210155) and ewe (VV210010) at the Australasian Dorset Championships, as well as the supreme exhibit of that show (VV210155) and grand champion ewe (VV210151). At the NSW Dorset Championships they took out supreme exhibit with their senior and grand champion ram, VV210155, as well as grand champion ewe with Valley Vista 210010, and champion mixed pair with VV 210155 and VV 210151. VV 210010 went on to be supreme Poll Dorset exhibit at the Australian Sheep and Wool Show, where Valley Vista also exhibited the champion and reserve champion mixed pairs.

#### Sire Summary 2023

**VV500-07:** A son of Kurralea 809-04, VV500 was a big bare pointed stylish ram that was very successful on the show floors. Was used again in stud as a specialist AI sire for producing rams for Merino operations.

**VVP41-09:** A very correct son of the above ram, VV500-07, used for the same reasons. These two rams had some of the best early growth rates every produced at Valley Vista.

**VV138-14 'FYFE':** Another Son of the great VV38-09. Producing a very exceptional line of progeny. Supreme Poll Dorset Ram at AS&WS 2015.

**VV58-17 (Mitchell):** Champion Ram NSW Dorset Championships and Champion Ram Australian Sheep and Wool Show. A T90/14 son. A very impressive young sire that over the years we hope will breed a sought after line of sons for our clients.

**VV493-18:** One of Andrew's favourites bred at Valley Vista, very impressive structure and balance, with topline and clean points that the Poll Dorset industry is after.

**VV514-19:** A son of TAT400-17, retained for structural correctness, this is his first crop of sons but keep an eye out over the years for many more as he has bred exceptionally well already. Low-birth weight sire.

**VV493-19:** By SW250-27, this is another low-birth weight sire. He's a clean pointed ram that has also bred exceptionally well in his first season at Valley Vista.

**VV86-20:** Retained sire from the 2020-drop, son of Derrynock 33-18. A high indexing fast growing sire that was used as a ram lamb and kept on at Valley Vista after impressive results in the Bowan Park trial and lambs on the ground at Valley Vista.

**VV06-21:** A very impressive Tattykeel 400-17 son that was one of the standout rams on the 2022 show circuit. Has been retained at Valley Vista, expect to see many sons over the coming years by this true to type, moderate framed, excellent structure sire that is truly relevant to today's industry expectations.

**Geredan 108-03:** A sire that came with the purchase of the Geredan stud ewes in 2007, this ram is a big, long bodied, deep carcass sire that played a huge role in the Geredan flock. Is a son of Geredan 101-01.

**Kurralea 809-04 (Phoenix):** Was purchased as part of the Geredan stud ewe deal, has bred exceptionally well at Valley Vista and used by many studs over the years. Has sired over 500 lambs at Valley Vista in his time.

**Aberdeen 16-12:** An Al sire used for his high accurate data to provide linkage within our flock. A very impressive drop of sons available.

**Tattykeel 90-14:** Purchased to continue our Tattykeel family. Was an outstanding ram lamb weighing 85kg at 5 months old. Champion Ram Lamb Australasian Dorset Championships 2014.

**Springwaters 250-17 (Taz):** Has been a very impressive Sire producing a stylish, fast maturing very sound line of offspring.

**Tattykeel 400-17 (Martin):** 1st June Drop Ram Australasian Dorset Championships. His line of sons in the sale will catch your eye and will suit both First-Cross and Merino operations.

**Derrynock 33-18:** Purchased for \$19,000 for his high indexing LambPlan data and impressive growth PEMD, and overall index.

**TAT 274-20:** Purchased for \$32,000 from Tattykeel in 2021, powerful bodied sire with all the traits that the Poll Dorset breed needs.

#### **ASBVS** and Indexes explained

#### What are ASBVs?

ASBVs are the units of measurement LAMBPLAN use to analyse animals. Australian Sheep Breeding Values are an estimate of an animal's true breeding value based on pedigree and performance recorded information. They are essentially a projection of how that animal's progeny will perform for a range of traits. Indexes combine important production traits into one number and are a useful way to rank animals quickly and easily.

#### **ASBV** types

#### Birth Weight (BW)

ASBV is based on measured birth weight of lambs adjusted for age of dam. Where birth weights are not available it is estimated as a correlated trait from weight measurements taken as the lamb matures. The lower the ASBV the lighter is the estimated progeny birth weight potential.

#### Weight (WWT) (PWWT)

ASBVs describe the animals' genetic merit for growth rate. A positive ASBV means the animal is genetically faster growing. Weight ASBVs are available for weaning (100 days), post-weaning (200 days), and yearling, hogget and adult ages.

#### Fat Depth (PFAT)

ASBVs describe the value of an animal's genes for fat depth at a constant weight – a negative ASBV means a genetically leaner animal.

#### Eye Muscle Depth (PEMD)

ASBVs describe the value of animals' genes for eye muscle depth at a constant weight – a positive ASBV means a genetically thicker muscled animal, and one that will have slightly more of its lean tissue in the higher-priced cuts.

#### TCP Index

The TCP index has been created to assist producers to achieve both gains in their major production traits, such as post-weaning weight and muscling, as well as ensuring consumer satisfaction from lamb is maintained through focusing on key eating quality traits such as shear force (tenderness) and intramuscular fat (marbling).

#### Intramuscular Fat

Intramuscular fat (IMF) is a measure of the chemical fat percentage in the loin muscle of a lamb and is often referred to as marbling. IMF has been shown to have a significant impact on the flavour, juiciness, tenderness and overall likeability of lamb. Rams with more positive Intramuscular Fat (IMF) ASBVs produce progeny with higher levels of intramuscular fat.



#### Ultrasonic Rib Eye Muscle Scanning In Live Sheep




Fig 1 - Exposed 12th rib on the carcase cut through the last thoracic

#### Meat Index

The meat index formula is based on the eye muscle width (A), eye muscle depth (B) and fat (C) measurements. A higher weighting is given to eye muscle width (A) because it is more heritable while eye muscle depth (B) is influenced by environmental factors. Fat (C) is penalised slightly. The resulting number is then adjusted for the age of the sheep to get an index.

#### NOTE:

- Current Live Weight = C/LW
- Eye Muscle Area (EMA) is calculated using the eye muscle width and eye muscle depth measurements.

#### **Ewe Family Breeding Lines**

Valley Vista ewe family breeding lines are indicated by their swing-tag colour. Sires are written above the ewe ID number on swing tags, and are also listed in the catalogue.

#### Red

This is Valley Vista's Tattykeel based family, consisting of hire quality sires purchased over the years including TAT90-14, TAT222-04, TAT400-17 and most recently this year's \$32,000 purchase TAT274-20.

#### Green

Green is Valley Vista's oldest family line, based around the Armdale and Armdale Park bloodlines. Currently the most prominent sires in this family are VV138-14 (Fyfe) and VV38-09. This is our most dominant female breeding line, producing ewes that's progeny are standouts each year.

#### **Purple**

This Is our New Zealand connected family, consisting of NZ sire purchased Huntington 33-03 (Wombat) and sons we've retained of his.

#### White

White indicates the Valley Vista Park prefix, which contains a mixture of bloodlines; you can refer to their sire numbers on top of the dam ID swing tag for their connections. Lots of outcross genetics in this line.

#### Yellow

This line are daughters of Derrynock 33-18, who was purchased for \$19,000 and bred on with a focus on Lambplan ASBVs.

#### **Orange**

Orange are the Springwaters 250-17 (Taz), another new sire purchased and producing a new family line in recent years.

#### **Joining Sires**

All joined sale ewes were pregnancy scanned on Thursday 22nd December 2022, to lamb early April 2023. Ewes have been running with rams up until date of sale. Ewes will be scanned again the day prior to the sale and any updated information provided on the supplementary sheet.

**VV138-14 'FYFE':** Another Son of the great VV38-09. Producing a very exceptional line of progeny. Supreme Poll Dorset Ram at AS&WS 2015.

**Derrynock 33-18:** Purchased for \$19,000 in 2019 for his high indexing LambPlan data, impressive growth PEMD, and overall index.



**VV06-21:** A very impressive Tattykeel 400-17 son that was one of the standout rams on the 2022 show circuit. Has been retained at Valley Vista, expect to see many sons over the coming years by this true to type, moderate framed, excellent structure sire that is truly relevant to today's industry expectations.

VV155-21: It's early to say, but this ram is probably the best ever bred at Valley Vista. An extremely successful show career, winning supreme exhibit at the NSW Dorset Championships and Australasian Dorset Championships, before being crowned the national Champion of Champion ram for the Poll Dorset breed for the year. He has the bone, structural and sire attributes that stands out in the breed, a powerful Hillden 110-19 son that you should expect to see a lot of over the next day at Valley Vista. **VV79-21:** A ram sold for equal top price of \$14,000 at the Australasian Dorset Championships in 2022, we retained semen in this sire for his structural correctness and the muscle in his carcass. Another young sire you will see pop up often in future sale rams. Had a very successful show year in the wool, winning senior champion ram at the Australian Sheep & Wool Show.
