Welcome to our 24th on property sale.

Firstly, a big thank you to all our clients past and present. Our sale last year averaged \$8256 for Bulls and \$4111 for Heifers, with a top price of \$23,500 and \$6,750 respectively. The first offering of Moderator sons and daughters were sort after and again he has stepped up to the mark in this year's draft.

Our Mantra remains consistency in our cattle. We urge you to look towards Mt William as a reliable place to invest in Charolais genetics.

There are several Elite young sires with Stud potential in this year's draft. However, the backbone of our programme are our commercial clients. It is evident the quality of the Mt William bulls you are buying now has increased significantly. To get strong consistent lines of quality progeny year after year, you need a strong female base. Mount William Charolais has had this at hand.

Charolais cattle have an important role to play in the beef industry. If we deviate too much from the core of what Charolais do well, then we risk losing relevance. Mt William bulls are bred for purpose. Weight for age, fast growth, extra performance, carcass merit, all profit drivers in a beef operation.

We make every effort to poll our herd without sacrificing performance. We source our polled genetics from studs with grounding. Studs who over the journey have consistently produced the right types of polled animals.

In September 2022 we journeyed to Palgrove where we purchased Lot 5, Palgrove Rain Dance for \$45,000. He is super thick, has natural softness and a great temperament. He has a medium frame ideal for our females, moderate birthweight, high positive- growth, milk, carcass weight and constitution.

The importance of investing in good bulls cannot be underestimated, in both stud and commercial operations. The group we have for sale contains some potent genetic combinations. Leading sires including Hannibal, Moderator, Duty-free, Puma and Precision have combined with our best females to give you this quality draft.

These bulls had a good start with strong weaning weights, followed by a tougher autumn. In true Charolais fashion they maintained and kicked on during the spring. They handled the wet

conditions very well highlighting their versatility. They will have good weight in them by sale day and will be Scanned in January for Fat EMA and IMF.

The heifers are a select group of feminine types with plenty of scope. They provide good vessels to improve your breeding progress. They have strong pedigrees; all have been joined to Talgoona Russell (a bull we purchased earlier this year at the Galvin's Inaugural Bull sale). The heifers will all be pregnancy tested in January prior to the sale. Only those heifers who scan in calf will be offered for sale.

Cattle markets have been extremely strong. Things have backed off to a degree but breeds that perform going forward will provide the most sustainability of profits to producers.

We recognise that despite trends in the end it's not the colour of the hide that counts, rather the performance of the animal. It was really validating to see 3 Charolais Bulls sell for over \$100,000 at Palgrove, and then three weeks later at Moongol a Charolais bull sell for \$265,000. These recent sales in Queensland have placed the Charolais bred in the company of any other breed in Australia in terms of recognition of their value in the industry. Pioneers including my Grandfather who first laid eyes on Charolais all those years ago and backed they would thrive in this country, would have found validation in these results.

An opportunity exists in the southern markets with the number of angus females. Educating the market as to the advantages and unlocking the potential of the Charolais over these females is something we at the Victorian Region of the Charolais Society have been promoting.

Being one of Australia's foundation herds and our investment in extra quality walking and AI sires has helped to put Mt William in its rightful place in the Australian Charolais spectrum. Decades of breeding leading Charolais genetics have resulted in genetic performance in the pedigrees being actualised.

We wish you well in your selections and thank you for your interest.

FERTILITY GUARANTEE: Bulls are sold as fertile and capable of natural service. All bulls are semen tested and reproductively structurally assessed by AB Nationwide. Any claim on a bull must be made within 12 months after sale date and be accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate. The Veterinary report must state that, the bull has not suffered any injury or maltreatment which could have affected his breeding ability since delivery to the purchaser. Bulls which do not breed will be replaced by an animal of equal value or a credit less salvage value at the next sale. This clause will be strictly adhered to. Strictly no cash refunds. We are only too happy to assist you with your selection.

All females are sold as guaranteed breeders. Where a Purchaser submits a Veterinary Certificate to the Vendor within 12 months of the date of sale, that a female of joinable age is infertile and in his/her opinion has not suffered any injury or maltreatment which could have affected her breeding ability, the Female will be replaced by an animal of equal value or a credit less salvage value at the next sale. This will not apply where an attempt has been made to transfer embryos from the female. All Heifers will be pregested via a scan prior to sale day. Certificates available. PTIC does not guarantee a live calf. A small percentage of heifers will absorb a pregnancy and Mount William Charolais are not liable in the event this occurs. An arbitrator appointed by the Auctioneers will settle any dispute.

HEALTH: The Mount William Herd is J-Bas 8. All Animals have been drenched and vaccinated with 7 in 1, Pestiguard and Vibrio in accordance with the Pfizer STAR BREEDER program. All sale Bull have been tested negative for Pesti Virus. The Mount William Herd has been tested negative for Pesti Virus. If you are concerned about the presence of Pesti Virus in your herd we suggest you consult a vet regarding a vaccination programme. All animals derive from an accredited Free T.B. and Brucellosis Herd. Any test required by interstate purchasers will be done at Mount William, at costs to the Vendor.

DELIVERY: Transport will be the responsibility of the Purchaser. Mount William will work in conjunction with McEwan's Livestock Transport to reduce transport costs to purchasers. Please speak to us or our Agents about your transport requirements.

INSURANCE: Insurance is available. We encourage you to consider insuring your purchase. Please speak with either Elders or Charles Stewart Howard.

REBATE: The Vendors agree to a rebate of 3% to outside agents who attend the sale or buy on behalf of their clients and settle within 7 days. Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs)

Calving Ease EBVs (%) are based on calving difficulty scores, birth weights and gestation length information. More positive EBVs are favourable and indicate easier calving.

- **CE % Direct = Direct Calving Ease** - The EBV for direct calving ease indicates the influence of the sire on calving ease in purebred females calving at two years of age.

- **CE % Daughters = Daughters' Calving Ease** - The EBV for daughters' calving ease indicates how easily that sire's daughters will calve at two years of age.

Gestation Length EBV (days) is an estimate of the time from conception to the birth of the calf and is based on Artificial Insemination and hand mating records. Lower (negative) Gestation Length EBVs indicate shorter gestation length and therefore easier calving and increased growth after birth.

Birth Weight EBV (kg) is based on the measured birth weight of progeny, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.

200-Day Growth EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth to early ages.

400-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.

600-Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Mature Cow Weight EBV (kg) is based on the cow weight when the calf is weighed for weaning, adjusted to 5 years of age. This EBV is an estimate of the genetic difference in cow weight at 5 years of age and is an indicator of growth at later ages and potential feed maintenance requirements of the females in the breeding herd. Steer breeders wishing to grow animals out to a larger weight may also use the Mature Cow Weight EBV.

Milk EBV (kg) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV indicates the effect of the daughter's milking ability, inherited from the sire, on the 200-day weights of her calves. For dams, it indicates her milking ability.

Scrotal Size EBV (cm) is calculated from the circumference of the scrotum taken between 300 and 700 days of age and adjusted to 400 days of age. This EBV is an estimate of an animal's genetic merit for scrotal size. There is also a small negative correlation with age of puberty in female progeny and therefore selection for increased scrotal size will result in reduced age at calving of female progeny.

Carcass Weight EBV (kg) is based on abattoir carcass records and is an indicator of the genetic differences in carcass weight at the standard age of 650 days.

Eye Muscle Area EBV (sq cm) is calculated from measurements from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcass data, adjusted to a standard 300 kg carcass. This EBV estimates genetic differences in eye muscle area at the 12/13th rib site of a 300 kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals. Sires with relatively higher Eye Muscle Area EBVs are expected to produce better muscled and higher percentage yielding progeny at the same carcass weight than will sires with lower Eye Muscle Area EBVs.

Rib Fat and Rump Fat EBVs (mm) are calculated from measurements of subcutaneous fat depth at the 12/13 rib site and the P8 rump site (from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcasses) and are adjusted to a standard 300 kg carcass. These EBVs are indicators of the genetic differences in fat distribution on a standard 300 kg carcass. Sires with low, or negative, fat EBVs are expected to produce leaner progeny at any particular carcass weight than will sires with higher EBVs.

Retail Beef Yield EBV (%) indicates genetic differences between animals for retail yield percentage in a standard 300 kg carcass. Sires with larger EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat EBV (%) is an estimate of the genetic difference in the percentage of intramuscular fat (marbling) at the 12/13th rib site in a 300 kg carcass. Depending on market targets, larger more positive values are generally more favourable.

Selection Indices

Northern Maternal Index [NMI]- Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial self-replacing herd where Charolais bulls are joined with Bos indicus cows in Northern Australia targeting the grass fed Jap Ox market. Selected heifers are retained for breeding and so maternal traits are of importance. Steers target 650 kg live weight (360 kg HSCW and 12 mm P8 fat depth) and heifers 630 kg (340 kg HSCW and 14 mm P8 fat depth), at 26 months of age. In response to industry feedback; positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Domestic Terminal Index [DTI]- Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial herd where Charolais bulls are joined with a British breed cow base (e.g. Angus) targeting the domestic trade. This index assumes all progeny will be marketed with steers finished in the feedlot for 90 days, and weighing 450 kg (250 kg HSCW and 7 mm P8 fat depth) when marketed at 12 months. Heifers will be in the feedlot for 75 days, and weigh 430 kg (230 kg HSCW and 9 mm P8 fat depth) at 12 months. In response to industry feedback, positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Accuracy

Accuracy (%) is based on the amount of performance information available on the animal and its close relatives - particularly the number of progeny analysed. Accuracy is also based on the heritability of the trait and the genetic correlations with other recorded traits. Hence accuracy indicates the "confidence level" of the EBV. The higher the accuracy value the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal or its relatives. Even though an EBV with a low accuracy may change in the future, it is still the best estimate of an animal's genetic merit for that trait. As more information becomes available, an EBV is just as likely to increase in value, as it is to decrease.

Accuracy values range from 0-99%. The following guide is given for interpreting accuracy:

- **less than 50%: Low accuracy.** EBVs are preliminary and could change substantially as more performance information becomes available.
- **50-74%: Medium accuracy.** Usually based on the animal's own records and pedigree.
- **75-90%: Medium-high accuracy.** Some progeny information included. EBVs may change with addition of more progeny data.
- **more than 90%: High accuracy** estimate of the animal's true breeding value.

As a rule, animals should be compared on EBVs regardless of accuracy. However, where two animals have similar EBVs the one with higher accuracy could be the safer choice, assuming other factors are equal.

COMMENTS: Moderator was purchased as Lot 9 in the 2018 Palgrove sale for \$23,000.

An extremely well balanced bull, structurally hard to fault. His phenotype and disposition are excellent. He has length, width and depth, coupled with an ideal maturity pattern and excellent foot and leg structure.

His Sire Jubilee was the high selling bull in Australia in 2015 (\$35,000) and an AI Sire at Palgrove.

He has joined our programme and moved quickly to be a lead sire, breeding extremely well and attracting interest along the way. Semen sold to Waterford Charolais resulted in Moderator embryos topping the 2019 Charolais National Sale at \$1,400.

We believe he will compliment the existing base of Hannibal females in the herd. He sired the top Price Bull in last years sale, Mt William Rome \$23,500.

COMMENTS: Hannibal was one of the sale features in Palgrove's 2014 sale. He is a polled red factor ET bull by Canadian National Champion PCC Sudden Impact. His donor Dam produced 6 sons, sold to Australian Studs for a \$23,000 average.

He has an exceptional pedigree, is a sensible mature size with natural thickness, plenty of softness and a sleek coat. His growth and carcase EBV's are outstanding.

Hannibal's notoriety has grown significantly in the past two bull selling seasons. 20 of his sons averaged \$10,850 at Mt William and in 2017 six sons averaged \$19,000 and topped the sale at \$40,000 at Palgrove.

Hannibal is one of those bulls who simply breeds true to form, above expectation, and has proven to be a standout for the modern Charolais breed. Hannibal's genetics are sought after and made their way to New Zealand in 2019.

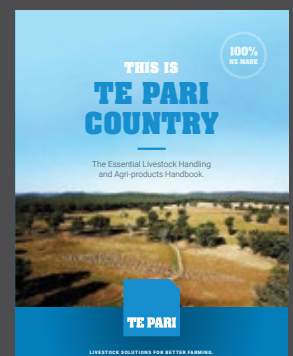
