## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All horses must be available for inspection prior to the sale.
- 2. Horses must be presented to the satisfaction of association inspectors. The inspectors may reject horses from the sale if the horse does not comply with the following conditions:
  - a. Markings and brands described on the entry form must be clearly visible and identical to the horse presented for inspection.
  - b. The horse should be prepared and presented suitable for sale.
  - c. The horse should be free of undesirable characteristics and conformation faults.
- 3. PRL/Rodwells reserves the right to restrict the number of entries.
- 4. Horses for the sale will be selected by criteria.
- 5. All vendors are encouraged to submit a video of their horses working at time of nomination for the Acting agents (PRL/Rodwells) to view and decide suitability to the PRL/Rodwells Performance Horse Sale.
- 6. There will be no refunds on acceptance of nominated horse/s into the select sale catalogue.
- 7. The acting agent (PRL/Rodwells) does not take any responsibility for any prohibited and/or administered drugs prescribed for the duration of the marketing and sale period of the nomination. It is the requirement of the vendor to provide details of administration of prescribed drugs during the sale period to include supporting documentation by qualified veterinarian. The acting agent (PRL/Rodwells) will take no responsibility and any sale may be rejected.
- 8. Each nomination will be charged a flat fee of \$250 (+GST) which is not refundable.
- 9. An Agent fee of 7.5% (+GST) will be charged to all lots sold.
- 10. There will be no refunds on unsold or withdrawn lots.
- 11. Vendor will be provided with a full copy of the conditions of sale.
- 12. Any information supplied on the nomination form that is found to be inaccurate or misleading may result in immediate disqualification from the sale and the nomination fees will be forfeited. Any vendor discovered misrepresenting a sale horse does so at the risk of being charged with a federal offence.
- 13. The agent reserves the right to reject any horse from the sale.
- 14. The agent reserves the right to edit/alter catalogue notes.
- 15. If the horses are being worked on cattle, the Vendor is required to submit a video of the horse being worked for viewing during the online sale. Videos can be emailed to <a href="mailto:zweidner@rodwells.com.au">zweidner@rodwells.com.au</a>
- 16. Embryos must be implanted into recipient mare and the recipient mare will become the property of the purchaser. A pregnancy certificate for the recipient mare (dated no earlier than 14 days prior to the sale and signed by a registered veterinarian) must be provided prior to the sale date. This condition also applies to natural pregnancies in broodmares.
- 17. Vendors or their nominated representative must be available by phone while their lot/s are being offered.
- 18. It is the vendor's responsibility to transfer of registration to the successful purchaser.
- 19. Confirmation of Vendor reserve price must be signed and returned to the selling agents 24 hours prior to the commencement of the auction. "No verbal instructions will be accepted"
- 20. Vendors are **NOT** to release any horse/s until the Selling Agent has contacted them to inform them that funds have been received. Doing so is at the vendors own risk.

## Terms for the Purchaser

- 21. No horse/s will be released without cleared funds.
- 22. Payment terms: The Purchaser will be invoiced at the conclusion of the sale and settlement made within 24hrs of receiving account. Method of payment is by EFT direct deposit. Booking to a stock agent will be accepted however confirmation from the agency settling on your behalf must be received prior to the sale commencing.
