Welcome to Mount Pleasant Limousins

Sale Preparation

All the bulls on offer have been prepared on a lucerne pasture with the access to a creep feeder of oats and access to mineral lick blocks. There has been no hoof trimming.

Junior Members

Junior Limousin Youth Members will be offered a 5% discount on all purchases.

Lunch and refreshments will be provided by Mount Pleasant Limousins at 12 0'clock.

Stud Transfers

All animals are registered with the Australian Limousin Breeders Society and they are eligible for transfer within. We ask all purchasers of animals who require transfers to indicate this on your "Buyers Instruction Slip" (page 31 of the catalogue).

Rebate

A 2% rebate is offered to outside agents who meet the following conditions.

- 1. Introduce their client in writing to the vendor by 5pm on the day prior to the sale.
- 2. Accompany their client at the sale.
- 3. Settle within 7 days.

Insurance

Purchases become the responsibility of the buyer at the fall of the hammer.

While all care will be taken by the vendors we recommend buyers insure their purchases. An insurance representative will be present at the sale.

Delivery and Transport

We are willing to hold bulls for a reasonable period after the sale to enable purchasers to coordinate the successful and efficient transport of the bull to their properties at the buyers risk, again all care will be taken by the vendor.

NOTE: On delivery of your new bull please ensure you have some steers or cows in the yards to ease the transition from the herd at home to their new environment. The bulls have been handled gently and moved by quad bike so with any new method of handling it should be taken slowly. There is no trailer loading facilities - only trucks

Guarantee

We guarantee the structural soundness and fertility of our sale bulls. If a bull proves to be infertile or incapable of natural service within 12 months of the sale date, the vendor will credit the purchase price less the salvage value of the bull provided the problem is not caused by injury, disease, misadventure or negligence incurred since taking delivery. Any claims must be accompanied by a relevancy veterinary certificate. The vendor reserves the right to obtain an independent veterinary assessment to confirm any claim.

What are scurs?

Some polled cattle have scurs. Scurs are incompletely developed horns that are generally attached only to the skin. They can range in size small scab like growths to large horn like protrusions. Therefore, polled cattle can either be smooth polled or scurred polled (polled but expressing scurs). Many breeders mistake the idea that scurs represent an error in transmitting the horned characteristic, but this is not the case:

Scurred cattle should be classified as polled since they do have the polled gene. Only a polled animal can have the scurred trait.

Understanding EBV's

An Estimate Breeding Value (EBV) is an estimate of the genetic merit of that animal for each trait measured.

EBVs are provided for the following traits:

Gestation Length:

Ranks sires for the time between conception and the birth of a calf. Shorter gestation is indicated by negative EBVs and longer by positive EBVs.

Calving Ease Direct:

Indicates the influence of the sire on calving ease. Sires with positive EBVs for calving ease will increase calving ease and sire with negative EBVs will decrease calving ease.

Birth Weight:

Indicates the genetic potential for birth weight. Positive EVBs indicate higher birth weights and negative EBVs indicate lower birth weights of progeny.

200, 400 & 600 Day Weight:

Gives us an estimation of the animals genetic potential for growth.

Milk:

A key component of fast growth to weaning is the dam's maternal performance. A bull with a high milk EBV should produce daughters which milk well.

Scrotal Size:

Indicates whether the bull will produce sons with above average or below average scrotal sizes.

Docility:

Is expressed as the increase or decrease in the percentage of the progeny that will be scored as docile (score 1 or 2). Positive EBVs indicate higher proportion or progeny that will be scored as docile and negative EBV's indicate a lower percentage of progeny being scored as docile.

The EBVs for Limousins can not be compared with EBVs for an animal of another breed

Accuracies are presented with each EBV and give and indication of the amount of information that has been used in the calculations of that EBV. The higher the accuracy the lower likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal and its relatives.

The EBV contained within this sale catalogue were compiled by the ABRI (Agricultural Business Research Institute) from the datasupplied by breeders. Neither the Australian Limousin Breeders' Society or ABRI oversee or audit the collection of this data.

New Suffixes for Limousin cattle

Following considerable research and consultation with a variety of stakeholders and consideration of member feedback on proposed changes to Limousin suffixes the Board is advising members of a new suite of suffixes that will come into effect as at 1 January 2023. Please note that whilst these suffixes officially take effect as 1 January 2023 they may appear on the database prior to this date or a short time after depending on ABRI's work to transition us to the new suite of suffixes. The new suffixes will be used in all of the extracts prepared for the 2023 sale catalogues.

The review of the Limousin suffixes was initiated after a number of members noted that the existing suffixes had evolved over time with technological advances and breed advancement. Their concerns were that this evolution had led to the use of a number of suffixes being used to describe the same status, e.g. 3 suffixes to describe an animal as homozygous polled, that leads to some confusion within the marketplace and hinders clear and intuitive understanding of the suffixes. It was noted by members that all methods of determining horn/poll and coat colour status had reached similar and acceptable accuracy to no longer need to differentiate in suffixes as to how the status was determined. In reviewing the Limousin suffixes the Board considered:

- Discussions with commercial buyers/users, agents and members who expressed
 opinions that our existing suffixes were confusing with a number of traits being
 represented by more than one suffix and some suffixes being less than intuitive.
- Reflection on the purpose and use of suffixes in relation to providing information to non-members and members in their decision-making processes when considering purchases to suit their breeding objectives.
- 3. A view of a growing number of members that the current suffixes have served their purpose as technology and herd status has evolved over a period of time but are now in some cases unnecessary.

The Board arrived at its position with general member consensus on the new suite of suffixes believing the proposed changes to be simple to understand and more intuitive than the current suffixes and brings us in line with or closer to many other breeds that have similar traits that suffixes are used for.

The Board emphasises that there is no intention to change information available on the Animal Enquiry page relating to how the status of the various suffix traits were determined. Full details of DNA test results would also continue to be reported as they are now. All suffix traits will be available as Animal Search filters to support members and non-members to search the Limousin database for potential animals with desired traits that may suit their breeding objectives.

The Board is appreciative of the time taken by members and non-members to provide feedback, comment and suggestions to assist the development of the new simplified and more intuitive suite of suffixes. See Opp. page for a summary of the new Limousin suffixes and how they will appear after animal names.

What is the F94L Gene?

The mutation known as F94L which has a high frequency in the Limousin breed is one of three missence mutations which does not cause a loss of function of the myostatin gene. It appears not to cause an increase in the size of the muscle fibres but does cause an increase in the number of muscle fibres. It is not associated with high levels of calving difficulty or lowered fertility and longevity.

What Are The Effects Of The Limousin Muscling Gene?

The research conducted by the Adelaide University group led by Dr Wayne Pitchford has clearly documented the effects of the Limousin muscling gene as shown below.

How Big Is The Effect If I Use A Limousin Bull Over Cows Of Another Breed?

Most Limousin bulls carry two copies of the Limousin muscling gene so each of the progeny will get one copy of the Limousin muscling gene. Animals with one copy of the gene are likely to exhibit about half the differences shown above. A Limousin cross calf is expected to have about 9.5% more silverside, 9.5% more eye muscle area 4% more retail beef yield, with a 3% increase in tenderness of the loin muscle and 5.5% more tender silverside.
