Terms & Conditions

- Buyers please note this sale will be run as a sequential sale in conjunction with a physical sale. The sale will be conducted at regular saleyard speed and buyers are encouraged to use Limit Bids or Auto Bids to ensure full participation. The auctioneer's decision is final.
- Buyers please note, photos in catalogue are indicative only of each vendors stock and updated photos will be added on sale day.
- NLIS transfers will be conducted by ScanClear at the conclusion of the sale, at a cost of \$2.20 per head.
- All lots will be sold on a dollars per head basis, with 10% GST added, after the knock down price.
- Beef Only Status, or BO, is in reference to female cattle that are eligible to cross the border from Victoria interstate. The majority of females in this sale are beef only, interstate buyers please take note of each female lot's status. Not applicable on steers. This information is stated in the assessments.
- Pens 1-29 (breeding females) Were weighed and assessed on farm in the 3 weeks leading up to the sale, these lots WILL NOT be reweighed at the sale.
- Pens 30 onwards (Steers & Heifers) will be individually weighed at the saleyards on Thursday afternoon/evening after a minimum 6 hour curfew, with a total estimated curfew stated on the assessments. Buyers to make own adjustments for further losses between weighing & loading.
- Any cattle weighed at the Myrtleford yards under the 6 hour curfew will have a delivery adjustment up to 5% taken off at the discretion of the independent level 1 AuctionsPlus assessor.
- Cattle will be weighed individually and the average weight will be displayed in the catalogue & on the physical pen card. Weights are as accurate as the assessors can provide, but are indicative only
- An independent Level 1 AuctionsPlus Assessor will be in attendance to oversee the weighing and final assessments for the online catalogue.
- Purchasers must advise the selling agent of transport arrangements within 1 hour of the completion of the sale.
- 7 days terms to approved buyers and those booking via ALPA agents, otherwise payment prior to delivery.
- Any cattle remaining at the Paul & Scollard Myrtleford saleyards after 10am Saturday 28th May will be fed hay at the purchaser's expense at \$3 per head per day.
- Delivery fee of \$1.00/hd for online buyers.
