

AuctionsPlus Sale Times

Eastern States Cattle and Tuesday and Thursday sheep sales will run <u>for</u> <u>a minimum of 30 minutes</u>. From the 30-minute mark, the timer controls the auction – if there is no bidding activity on any lot within 20 seconds, the sale will close.

<u>Sales are managed by the auction timer</u> – the clock counts down and when it is at 20 second increments, it will automatically close the sale if there is no bidding activity within the 20 seconds.

If there is lots of bidding activity the sale will run for longer than 30 minutes, the length will be determined by the market, not AuctionsPlus staff.

As of the 1st of January AuctionsPlus will be sticking strictly to the following format:

	Eastern States Cattle
10am	Sale begins
10:30am	Auction can finish any time after 10:30
11am	Second Eastern States Cattle Sale begins
	Tuesday & Thursday Sheep Sales
1pm	Sale begins
1:30pm	Auction can finish any time after 1:30pm
2pm	Second Sheep Sale begins

The aim of this is to provide structure and understanding of the auction times to buyers while delivering an efficient sale, ensuring vendors stock receive significant marketing exposure.

Moving forward, all Auction Catalogues, pre-media, newsletters and general communications will include the specific time schedule for the auctions (shown above) – note WA, Tasmania and Roberts Sales will run for a minimum of 20 minutes. Please ensure you check the sale catalogues for times.



Market Operators will continue to call buyers at the start of the sale notifying them of stock that match

their specifications.

Dropouts for those on computers in remote and regional areas with poor internet connectivity will be

continued to be monitored and sales may have delays should drop outs occur - this does not apply to

people bidding on phones and iPads in poor service areas.
